<u>SUMMARY</u>					
<p>On 22 April 69 between Oeon and Seoul, Korea, along the Main Supply Route (MSR) # 1, filming was completed on the "stringing crew", one of six crews under contract awarded by the US Army Corps of Engineers District, Far East to the joint venture of Stoltz Inc., Santa Fe Engineers Inc., and the Korean Development Corporation.</p> <p>The contract is the construction of Korea's first cross-country petroleum (POL) pipeline. The pipeline, when completed, will extend approx 250 miles from Pohang to Seoul. It will have the capability of moving four different petroleum products through the same line.</p> <p>The POL system is being constructed for United Nations Forces, Korea (UNFK) and will serve Army and Air Force installations along the route.</p>
