<p>On 22 May 1969, in Tongduchon, ROK (approx 57kms NE of Seoul), construction was in progress on the Tongduchon Primary School. The school is being constructed under the Armed Forces Assistance to Korea (AFAK) Program, which advise and assist the Korean orphanage and educational programs. Specifically, assistance rendered is material given and transported to sites for the construction of buildings.</p>

			<p>Under the AFAC Program, regular monthly meetings are held between the Civil Affairs Section (C-5), 7th Inf Div, the mayor's office and various officials of the health, education and welfare offices of the town of Tongduchon, to discuss civic action projects that would benefit the community.</p> <p>Upon the councils acceptance of a specific project, a plan must be submitted to the council and forwarded to 8th US Army for approval. Upon approval, supplies are then drawn and sent to the locals in which the project is to be initiated. Also, an engineer is appointed to oversee the proper use of materials and to advise whenever requested. All labor is conducted by the local Korean Nationals and some assistance is given from military (US) personnel at Camp Casey. Upon completion of the project, a dedication with plaque ceremony is held. The construction is usually completed within 2-3 months depending on the availability of materials.</p> <p>Since the AFAC Programs began in July of 1968, the division counts eight (8) orphanages and five (5) schools completed as of this date. Currently under construction at this time are: Hanil Women's Vocational School, Tongduchon Boy's Vocational School, Tongduchon Primary School (depicted in this film shipment), Sinchung Middle and High School, Tongduchon Reconstruction School and the Repatri Reservoir.</p> <p>The Tongduchon Primary School will house over 700 children and because of the large number of children, they will be taught in shifts.</p> <p>This shipment up-dates the previous shipment which began with the construction of the Tongduchon Primary School.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">(2)</p>
