All other rolls, normal processing.</p> <p align="center"><u>COVERAGE OBJECTIVE:</u></p> <p>The objective of this coverage is to depict elements of the 127th Signal Battalion, 7th Infantry Division, performing the Organizational Readiness Test (ORT), involving new and more complicated Signal equipment for overseas field use.</p> <p>This coverage is a team-initiated project and the photography is directed toward historical documentation and to both specific and general audiences that have interest in signal units in the field.</p> <p>This film depicts "A" Co., 127th Sig Bn, initiating their annual ORT, consisting of technical and tactical operations. The technical operation consist of assembling the AN/MRC-115 Radio Relay Set, personnel operating the SB-611/MRC patch panel and SB-86 switch boards. Tactical operations include perimeter defense, the camouflaging of vehicles, etc.</p> <p>The unit was being graded by umpires designated from Headquarters Detachment, 127th Sig Bn.</p>
