McCain, Jr. Commander in Chief, Pacific), at Kimpo International Airport. Cut-away shots, are shown of the Republic of Korea Honor Guard. The USAF 707 jet aircraft is shown taxiing to a nearby reviewing stand where the Honorable David Packard stepped off the aircraft and was greeted by Republic of Korea's Prime Minister, Chung Ill Kwon, ADM John S. McCain, Jr. Commander in Chief, Pacific, Honorable William J. Porter, US Ambassador to Korea, GEN Charles H Bonesteel, III, Commander in Chief, United Nations Command/Commander US Forces Korea, LTO John H Michaelis, Deputy Commanding General, Eighth US Army and other assembled dignitaries and official visitors.</p> <p>The Deputy Secretary was then accompanied to the reviewing stand by Prime Minister Chung, for the playing of the national anthems of the United States and the Republic of Korea.</p> <p>Following the rendering of honors, Secretary Packard and Prime Minister Chung is shown stepping from the reviewing stand and onto an open vehicle where they passed and reviewed the Republic of Korea Honor Guard.</p> <p>Completing the pass and review, Secretary Packard and Prime Minister Chung is shown being returned to the reviewing stand.</p>
