SUBJECT: LOI 4-69 - Standards of Conduct

SEE DISTRIBUTION

1. Detachment commanders will insure that all personnel assigned, have read and are familiar with the provisions of AR 600-50, "Standards of Conduct for Department of the Army Personnel."

2. The following passages are extracted as being of special interest to all concerned:

Para 1: "Violations of this regulation may be cause for appropriate disciplinary action which may be in addition to any penalty provided by law."

Para 3: Department of the Army personnel will not engage in any private business or professional activity or enter into any financial transaction which involves the direct or indirect use, or the appearance of use, of inside information gained through a Department of the Army position to further a private interest or for private gain for themselves or another person or entity, particularly one with whom they have family, business, or financial ties."

3. At no time will personnel transport to or utilize personal cameras, tape recorders, etc. while in the performance of assigned photographic projects. This does not preclude transport of cameras from home station to temporary duty station for use during off duty time.

4. At no time will personnel utilize U.S. Government equipment and/or expendable items for other than official missions.

5. Detachment commanders will strictly enforce the provision of this LOI.
