America's war dogs were trained to recognize booby traps, mines, tunnels and weapons caches. They warned troops about ambushes. They saved lives by dragging wounded soldiers to safety.

America's war dogs prevented over 10,000 casualties in Vietnam alone and bravely served our country in Operation Desert Storm as well as WW II. Yet, many of these canine heroes were declared "surplus armaments" and either euthanised or left to unknown fates.

On President's Day (Monday, Feb. 21), these dogs will be honored by a memorial befitting their status as America's forgotten heroes.
