SUBJECT: Redesignation of the Military Dog Training Center
and Activation of the Military Dog Breeding Station.

In execution of the referenced Letter, this Memo
has the purpose of prescribing the following procedures:

- Redesignation of the Military Dog Training Center.
- Activating the Military Dog Breeding Station.

I. REDESIGNATION OF THE MILITARY DOG TRAINING CENTER:

As of 1 May 1962, the designation of the Military
Dog Training Center which was activated by the referenced
Memo is changed to:

- The Military Dog Replacement and Training Center.

II. ACTIVATION OF THE MILITARY DOG BREEDING STATION:

Also as of 1 May 1962, a Dog Breeding Center is
activated and designated as:

- THE MILITARY DOG BREEDING STATION

This Station is subordinate to the R&D Center
regarding Command and the Office of the Surgeon General regarding
techniques.

III. TOE:

The new TOEs for the Military Dog Replacement and Training Center as well as the Military Dog Breeding Station will be published later.

IV. PERSONNEL:

Based on the TOE:

- The Office of the Surgeon General will provide the above two units with Veterinarians and Veterinary Assistants as well as Veterinary technicians and specialists.

- Other personnel will be provided by Joint General Staff, J1 according to recommendations by the Center and Station Commanders.

- The Office of the Surgeon General made the recommendation to Joint General Staff, AG Division* that a Veterinarian Officer be made the Commander of the Military Dog Breeding Station.

V. EQUIPMENT:

- The Military Dog Replacement and Training Center will temporarily use the equipment on hand. The equipment will be completely replaced in compliance with the new TOE.

- The Military Dog Breeding Station will be provided with complete equipment from JGS/J4 in the form of a loan while waiting for the official version of the TOE to be published.

VI. STATION LOCATION AND BARRACKS:

- The Military Dog Replacement and Training Center will move to a station position at THANH TUY HA.

- The Military Dog Breeding Station will be stationed at GO VAP in the barracks presently occupied by the Military Dog Training Center.

VII. ADMINISTRATION:

Regarding Administration:

- The above two Military Dog Centers will be administered by the CONG HOA General Hospital.

Regarding Supplies:

- The above two Military Dog Stations will be autonomous units regarding supply. The support schedule will be published later by JGS/J4.

VIII. OFFICIAL STATEMENTS:

The Office, Director General of Administration, Budget and Accounting will appoint Officers to make the official activation statement and change the designation of the two Centers in compliance with current procedures.

The Chief, III CALC will examine and sign this official statement.

IX. STRENGTH REPORTS:

The CONG HOA General Hospital will make out strength reports on form 101/QS and 102/QS in compliance with procedures prescribed in Directive Nr 0341-TTM/I/TK/MK dated 21 January 1969 for the Military Dog Breeding Station as of 1 May 1969. Also as of 1 May 1969, reports will be designated as the Military Dog Replacement and Training Center instead of the Military Dog Training Center. Initial reports for the Military Dog Breeding Station and reports designated as the Military Dog Replacement and Training Center will be made out on 15 May 1969.

If the Military Dog Breeding Station has no personnel strength, a negative report will also be made.

X. TRAINING STATUS REPORTS:

The provisions of Memo Nr 2089/TTU/PQH/4 dated 16 August 1961 will be correctly applied regarding making out the monthly reports on the personnel status and training status of the Military Dog Replacement and Training Center.

XI. EXECUTION REPORTS:

The C.O., Military Dog Training Center is responsible for changing the designation of the Military Dog Training Center.

The Office of the Surgeon General is responsible for activating the Military Dog Breeding Station.

Execution reports on the above details will be forwarded to JGS (J1, J4 and BOI).
