SUBJECT: Safety Over Labor Day

All Personnel

1. The National Safety Council maintains accident data on five major holidays; of these five, only Christmas outranks Labor Day as the most dangerous season of the year. Each year a large number of persons lose their lives because they fail to observe a few simple rules of safety during this three day holiday period.
