Dear Friend,

The enclosed report celebrates AGAPE's fifth anniversary of grantmaking! We are happy to share this report of our recent activities and projects with you. Since 1970 we have accomplished much more than we ever imagined possible. Many, many supporters in both large and small ways have enabled these projects to happen. Nearly \$200,000 has been raised for projects. It would be impossible to measure the trust and moral support which we have been given and in turn passed on. The work described in this report speaks for itself. Each project, either entirely or in part, was engendered or realized because AGAPE exists. All of these projects were supported with your help.

Upon reading this report, we hope that you are moved to send us back a birthday present! It is through this spirit of sharing support that non-violent social change work flourishes.

AGAPE is presently hardpressed for funds. On pages 29 and 30 are brief descriptions of some of the projects for which we are seeking funds totalling over \$50,000! We have only \$2,330 for these projects. We are now trying to raise funds for specific projects such as those described and to increase our support from the general public since our two major donors have depleted their resources. Small contributions and pledges have been our most constant source of support over the years. As we approach the end of the year, we wanted to remind you that all contributions reduce your taxable income. Your measurable contribution coupled with a thousand others makes an immeasurable difference.

For the first time the office is going to have a space of its own outside of my home. We will be moving in the fall to the Bay Guardian building at 19th and York Streets in San Francisco. We are in great need of office furniture and equipment: file cabinets, desks, chairs, a couch, desk and floor lamps, and bookshelves. We also need volunteers to come in and work a couple of days a month. Donations of equipment can also be tax-deductible.

Please help us forge ahead at this critical juncture in AGAPE's and the nonviolent movement's history. Many thanks for your support from the Board of Trustees, the projects, and their staffs. Stay well.
