We, at Agape, believe it's happening. The Nonviolent Movement for Social Change is stirring to life with new strength. New England's Clamshell Alliance, the "Handicapped" sit-ins and Stanford's anti-apartheid protest represent the exciting renaissance we've all been struggling towards.
