## DANGEROUS SCOT: The Life and Work of an American "Undesirable"

John Williamson. The author came to this country from Scotland at the age of ten and was deported as an "alien undesirable" when he was 52. The highlight of this autobiography is his story of the great labor upheavals of the 1930s when, in Chicago and Cleveland, the author played a significant role in the struggles of the unemployed and particularly in the organization of the new industrial unions in rubber, auto and steel. He also throws new light on the role of Communists in the trade unions, the reasons for the split in the CIO and the fight against the Taft-Hartley Law.
