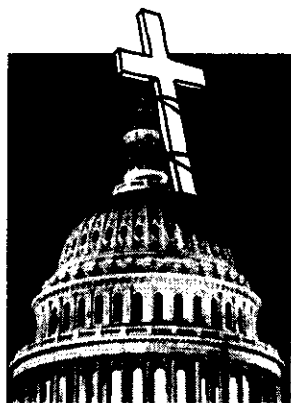

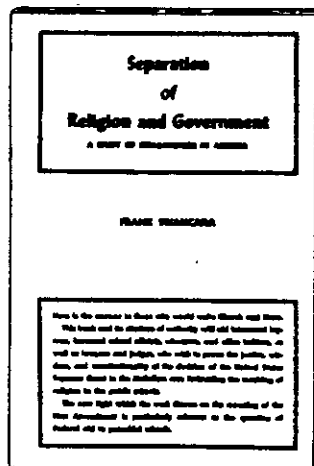

## Separation

The writing of this book was begun as a result of the author seeing some of the bitter criticisms of the *McColum* decision (mentioned in Chapter XI) which was handed down by the Supreme Court in 1948. This case concerned religious classes being taught by clergy in public school buildings at taxpayer expense. Also discussed at length is the *Everson* case of 1947 concerning the busing of students to religious schools with public school buses at taxpayer expense. These are the two most famous, early cases reviewed by the Supreme Court after World War II.

More importantly, however, this book contains primary document research material on both James Madison's and Thomas Jefferson's concerns with respect to the question of separation of state and church. It also contains the 1st and 14th Amendments to the U.S. Constitution with discussion of each.

Whoever is interested in Separationism should read this work. It throws new light on the First Amendment and is particularly relevant to the question of federal aid to parochial schools. With the New Right now attempting to gain more federal aid for church schools this book is an important historical reference source.

This newly released booklet is Albert Ellis at his best. When he addressed the 10th Annual National Convention of American Atheists in Chicago, IL, 1975, he presented a speech entitled "The Case Against Religion". This was subsequently printed, with his permission, as a small booklet by American Atheist Press. It has remained a *best seller* from that date with its down-to-earth layman language and short, swift, effective punches at religion.

In 1984 Dr. Ellis expanded and updated his remarks. He again gave American Atheist Press permission to print the revised edition. Both are reproduced in this single booklet. One can see from reading them together, how Dr. Ellis' ideas have changed thru experience. His basic premise is: "All true believers in any kind of orthodoxy ... are distinctly disturbed, since they are obviously rigid, fanatic, and dependent individuals ... Many liberal religionists of various groups are ... emotionally childish."

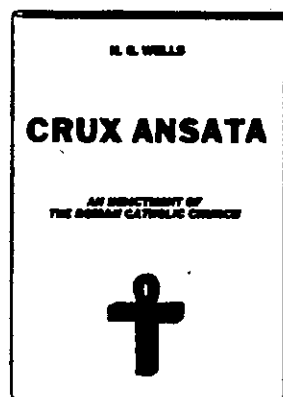

The U.S. government had, refused a visa to Bertrand Russell, who had been invited to lecture in New York, and it, at first, did not permit Allegro's *The Sacred Mushroom and The Cross* into the U.S.

Dr. Madalyn O'Hair, founder of American Atheists, (her *Freedom Under Siege* offered in this same flyer) personally smuggled her own copy of Allegro which she purchased in Canada. Her own F.B.I. file revealed one final evaluation of her by J. Edgar Hoover, which in part explains why the U.S. government has acted like this. "This women" wrote Hoover, "is attempting to destroy our national heritage."

*Crux Ansata*, H.G. Wells' vicious attack on the Roman Catholic Church was one of the books forbidden into this country. That is exactly why American Atheist Press chose to reprint it. The book includes an appendix which tells of the difficulty H.G. Wells had with this book. It is priced a little higher than our other selections of its length but you can't get it anywhere else and it is a rare item indeed.

## The Zionist Connection II

### What Price Peace?

by Alfred M. Lilienthal



Here is the new book about Middle East problems that shook the world in its revised and updated edition.

Speaking with a moral authority few Christians can command, author-historian Alfred Lilienthal gives the background of the forces that have already brought four wars to the turbulent Middle East since the creation of the state of Israel in the heart of the Arab world and since related displacement of the Palestinians. He points out how the politicization of the Jewish people, confusing "home" with "state" and "religion" with "nationalism," underlies the Arab-Israeli conflict.

Behind the increasing involvement of the U.S. he finds the meticulous organization of Zionism reaching into the White House, mobilizing public opinion, exercising control over Congress, repressing opposition through anti-Semitic labeling, and exerting inordinate influence over the media of information.

This provocative, timely book presents arguments that cannot be ignored by anyone concerned with human rights, the increasing U.S. dependence on Arab oil, and the dangers of nuclear confrontation. Dr. Lilienthal, a graduate of Cornell University and Columbia Law School, served with the Department of State and had a tour of Army duty in the Middle East during World War II. He has annually toured the Middle East, returning from war-torn Beirut in July 1978. Since 1968 he has published and edited the monthly newsletter *Middle East Perspective* and is an accredited correspondent at the United Nations.

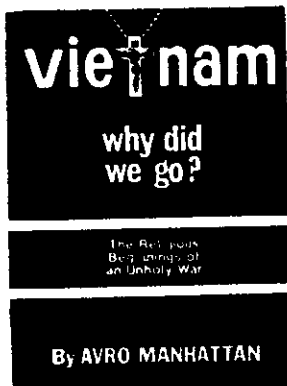

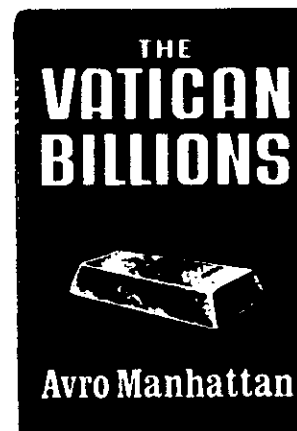

## THE VATICAN BILLIONS

Avro was born in Italy where he studied philosophy, social science and religion. During World War II he operated an English radio station called "Radio Freedom," broadcasting to occupied Europe. He also wrote political commentaries for the B.B.C.. He was a close friend of H. G. Wells and an associate of George Bernard Shaw. His 14 theopolitical books were distributed throughout the world, but with much difficulty. His works have been censored or suppressed by almost every government in the world but particularly those in which the Roman Catholic church has political power.

Manhattan has been writing for over 35 years and his field of specialization is the Roman Catholic church. The book begins with the beginning of the Roman Catholic church and it concludes with the financial position of that church, yesterday, throughout the world.

Avro savagely exposes it all, his pen tipped in the venom of an exposé who is angry with the deceits practiced by this church. This book will open new avenues of thought for any reader. On a scale of one to ten as to which author one should seek out to know the Roman Catholic church, Avro Manhattan is number one. ## A Window On Catholicism

This provocative book is another in the anti-Catholic series which was printed during the time John F. Kennedy, a Roman Catholic, was running for the presidency of the United States. In 1928 another Roman Catholic had tried to gain that office, governor Al Smith of New York. The writer of the book feels it important to analyze Smith's statements in respect to his church in 1928 and use this as a lesson of the ignorance of the most ordinary Roman Catholics in respect to papal encyclicals or church rulings. The book could well be characterized as a mish-mash produced in the heat

of a presidential campaign, but in it are a number of ideas which have now developed more fully and constitute the basis of "American Catholicism" as practiced by ordinary Catholics in the United States as distinguished from "Roman Catholicism" which is the church dominant, extending its proclamations and promulgations throughout the world.

The author uses a political incident (*A small Atheist brochure is included in the book relating a World War II event which was its basis.*) concerned with president Kennedy to illustrate that "... there is NO such thing as American Catholicism . . . that there is no Catholicism except Roman Catholicism." The book is a handy, easily read, small outcry against papal absolutism. It is especially good for Atheists who have escaped from Roman Catholicism and will give them further insight into the political and other machinations of their former church.

## Fourteen Leading Cases on Education, Religion and Financing Schools

an edited case law collection



This is a complete and unabridged text of the court opinions in eight state/church separation cases having to do with religion in the public schools or the financing of religious schools. This book is just exactly what you have needed to be informed on all these classic landmark U.S. Supreme Court decisions.

The editors chose exactly the right cases to reprint from the government publications. The case of *Abington School District v. Schempp*, and *Murray v. Curlett* lead off the publication. The latter was the famous case in which then Madalyn Murray partici-

pated in 1963 which led to the ban of prayer recitation and bible reading in the public schools of the United States.

But, just as important are: *Board of Education v. Allen* on the "loaning" of taxpayer purchased books to parochial schools; *Engel v. Vitale*, which ruled out a government composed prayer in school, *Everson v. Board of Education*, which permitted the busing of students to parochial schools at taxpayer expense; *Lemon v. Kurtzman*, wherein reimbursement to parochial schools for teachers' salaries and textbooks was held unconstitutional; *McCollum v. Board of Education*, which held religious classes in public schools unconstitutional; *Tilton v. Richardson*, wherein building grants to church related colleges and universities were ruled unconstitutional; and *Zorach v. Clauson* in which "released time" was approved by the Court.
