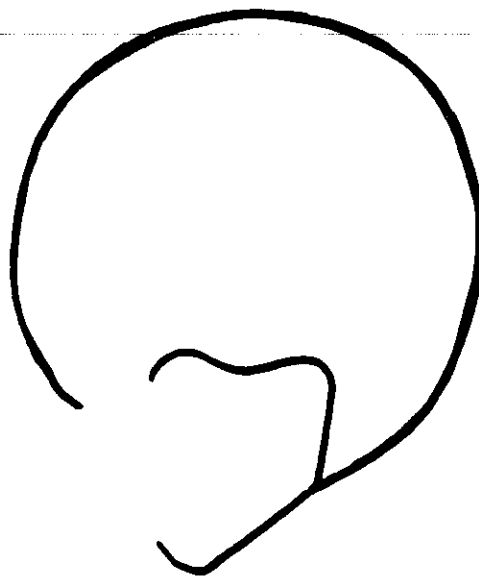

JUDITH APPLEBY - AB Journalism. Writer and editor, specialist in police training; Chapter Board and Secretary, 1969-71; Board member, Youth for Service, EPA.

JERRY E. BERG - Attorney. BA and LLB Stanford University; Chapter Board, 1968-71; Chairman, Selective Service System Section, Santa Clara County Bar Association; past board member of Friends Outside and Santa Clara County Community Legal Services. Formerly legal consultant to Public Administration Service (affiliated with the University of Chicago) and International Law Advisor to the President of Malawi (Maxwell Fellow, Ford Foundation).

LEN EDWARDS - Attorney. BA Wesleyan University, LLB University of Chicago. Attorney in Santa Clara Public Defender's Office for past three years; intern in civil rights activities in Mississippi, 1964; Peace Corp in Malaysia for two years.

ROBERT B. EVANS - Youth Service Administrator. Program Director, Community Youth Responsibility Program, EPA; member of Midpeninsula Urban Coalition, San Mateo County Task Force on Law and Justice, Ravenswood High School Human Relations Advisory Team, EPA-Belmont Parents Coalition; board member, Sequoia Branch Red Cross.

MARLENE LEVENSON - Chapter Membership Chairman since 1967, Chapter Board since 1968; directed ACLU membership campaigns; delegate to ACLU Western Region Chapter Conference; member of Watchdog and Police Complaint Committees; League of Women Voters member and participant in study on Juvenile Justice in California; Remedial Reading Summer Program and Headstart volunteer teacher; member of Palo Alto-Stanford Democratic Club, Common Cause and Palo Alto Civic League.

SANFORD LEVINSON - BA Duke University, Ph.D. Harvard. Student at Stanford University Law School; taught political science at Ohio State University 1968-70; member of Watchdog Committee; interested in rights of students, prisoners and mentally ill. (One year term)

ANDREW LIPPS - BA Trinity College. Student at Stanford University Law School. Intern in ACLU national office, including work with Academic Freedom Committee under Alan Reitman and legal dept. research for ACLU staff lawyer Larry Sager.

BETTY MITCHELL - Teacher. Charter member of Forum, member of Civil Liberties Committee, WILPF and American Federation of Teachers. Chapter Board member since 1966, serving on Nominating and Watchdog Committees; worked in Girls' Industrial School, Ohio and became interested in prison reform; interested in helping farm workers and in abolishing the death penalty.
