Virginia is one of only two state affiliates which have no staff lawyer. Although all ACLU work depends largely on volunteer services from practicing lawyers, a staff counsel performs the following services:

Serves as DIRECTOR OF LITIGATION, coordinating and assisting volunteer attorneys in Civil Liberties cases. Serves as SPOKESMAN for the affiliate in legal matters. Keeps volunteer attorneys informed about RECENT DEVELOPMENTS in the law. Acts as LIASON with the National ACLU office and with other state affiliates on questions affecting national interests. ADVISES the state Board and local boards on questions of ACLU policy. Serves as EMERGENCY COUNSEL in any state case. Handles COMPLEX CASES which cannot properly be undertaken by volunteers.
