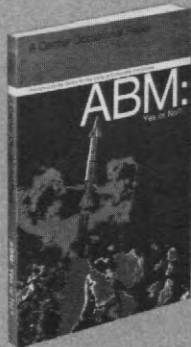

"The Center for the Study of Democratic Institutions must ask to be judged in terms of its purpose. That purpose is educational.

"It is not to influence the day-to-day actions of those who run, or are supposed to run, our society. If those actions are affected, then The Center may permit itself a certain measure of gratification.


"But it ought not to be carried away and fancy itself as a behind-the-scenes formulator of government policy, a think-tank for public or corporate officials.

"Its object is to understand and to promote understanding of the basic issues that underlie the formulation of public policy.

"It is possible that in the coming years The Center will try to clarify issues of world development, multi-national corporations, conglomerate mergers, the control of science and technology, the role of the professions, the meaning of modern federalism, and the future of the city.
