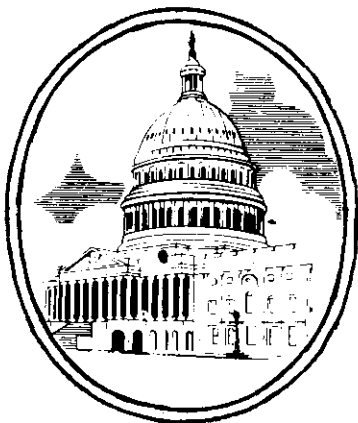

COST — The cost of tuition is \$20.00 for the entire seminar or \$2.00 per lecture. No charge for film showings or free speech sessions.

TUITION SCHOLARSHIPS — So that no one may be excluded on financial grounds, tuition scholarships will be granted on request.

FULL SCHOLARSHIPS — Full scholarships for tuition, food and lodging will be granted to students, teachers, policemen, and clergymen who will wish to attend the seminar and stay at the Ramada Inn Downtown. The value of each scholarship will be \$55.00, which will include \$20.00 for tuition and a grant of \$35.00 for food and lodging. Scholarships will not be granted to applicants under 16 years unless they are accompanied by a responsible adult.

FACULTY



MISS JUANITA CASTRO, younger sister of Cuba's Communist dictator. A graduate of the Ursuline Academy in Havana, she helped Fidel rise to power, then devoted herself to welfare work. After realizing that her brother and his government were Communist, she helped many Cubans to escape. She fled the country on June 29, 1964, in order to denounce Communism to the world.

Miss Castro has testified before the Senate Internal Security Subcommittee, and has appeared on Meet the Press and many other nationwide programs.



M. STANTON EVANS Graduate from Yale University where he edited Comment magazine and was Feature Editor of the Yale Daily News. He is former Managing Editor of the Washington Newsletter, Human Events, Assistant Editor of The Freeman, regular contributor to and Associate Editor of National Review. He is Chairman of the American Conservative Union and Commentator on C-B-S Television and Radio. He is presently Editor of the Indianapolis News.



JOSEPH DUNNER Dr. Joseph Dunner is Senior Professor and Chairman of the Political Science Department at Yeshiva University, New York City.

Before coming to Yeshiva University, he taught at Grinnell College in Iowa and was a Fulbright Professor of Political Science at Freiburg University in Germany.

Among the books authored by Dr. Dunner are "The Republic of Israel: Its History and Its Promise"



HERBERT A. PHILBRICK, author, lecturer and former counter spy for the F.B.I. He is author of the book "I Led Three Lives", which has been dramatized on television.



FRED C. SCHWARZ, M.D. President of the Christian Anti-Communism Crusade, became involved in the conflict with Communism while a student at the University of Queensland in Australia in 1940, because its atheistic nature conflicted with his Christian faith. He is the author of many pamphlets and the book "You Can Trust the Communists (to be Communists)," which has been translated into sixteen foreign languages and has sold over one million copies. His latest book is "The Three Faces of Revolution."



CHARLES E. RICE Presently Professor of Law, Notre Dame Law School, South Bend, Indiana. He received a Doctor of Juridical Science from New York University School of Law in 1962.

He formerly taught at Fordham University School of Law and at New York University School of Law and History and Political Science at C. W. Post College.

He has authored several books and written widely on constitutional law and related subjects. Some of the books he has written are: "Freedom of Association," "The Supreme Court and Public Prayer," and "The Vanishing Right to Live."



REV. JAMES D. COLBERT, Chairman of the Board and Director of Missions of the Christian Anti-Communism Crusade, Inc, is a minister and lecturer and has studied and observed conditions on ten world Communist fronts.



RAYMOND ALCIDE JOSEPH, B.A. Wheaton College, M.A. University of Chicago. Haitian national, student of social and political conditions in the Caribbean.
