Dear Friend,

The following report appeared in the November 12 edition of the Australian magazine, NEWS WEEKLY.

"A Ukrainian priest, Fr. Michael Luckyj, was hanged by agents of the KGB last January for saying Mass and distributing Communion. This has now been revealed by the Vatican newspaper, Osservatore Romano.

"Fr. Luckyj, of Drohovyc, in the Ukraine, was warned three times by the KGB--the Soviet secret police--that these activities were illegal. Plainclothes KGB officers called at his home and asked him to come with them and visit a sick parishioner. He was taken out and hanged."

It must be hard to convince priests and other persecuted religious workers of the virtues of detente.

This is not the time to relax in the fight against communism. Here is an encouraging report:

"I served as a senator for 12 years (1961-1973) in the Turkish Senate. During this time, in the Inter-Parties Anti-Communist Commission which I established in the parliament, and also in the activities of the numerous organizations which we established in Turkey to combat communism, I repeatedly made use of your book on a vast scale. In addition, during the years 1962-63 in a 12-session seminary which I arranged in the Ankara Turkocagi (a Turkish Youth Organization), using your book as a basis, I had taught your writings to the young people.

"I, too, am a medical doctor, pediatrics is my field, but I have also dedicated myself to fighting against communism since 1932.

"If you would be kind enough to autograph and send me a bound copy of your book, I would be extremely grateful.

"Once again I send you my eternal regards and gratitude, and hope that we may always continue our correspondence." (Name withheld)
