Dear Friend,

I welcome our new readers from the Accuracy in Media mailing list and look forward to a long era of mutual friendship and service. I again commend the AIM REPORT to all who are concerned about the left-wing bias of the media. It is too soon to report the response to my plea for the \$60,000 which we need, but early indications are encouraging. I urge all friends of the anticommunist cause to send their gifts promptly.

James Colbert, our Chairman, has just returned from a visit to anticommunist colleagues in Africa and India. His enthusiasm for the quality of the character and ministry of our friends is matched only by his alarm about the activities and progress of the communists. His report will be published in our June 15 newsletter.

Our need for \$60,000 has been caused by an effective anticommunist program overseas. Some of our very best friends write to us urging us to concentrate our anticommunist activities within the United States. They point out that this country is the world's last and best bastion of freedom and that, if this country falls to communism, the whole world will be lost.

This is obviously true, and it is the reason I have left Australia and have concentrated my energies in the battle against communism here. However, it does not mean that what happens in the rest of the world is irrelevant to the battle within the U.S.A. Events taking place thousands of miles away create grave consequences here. In Southern California, there have been long lines at the gas pumps and delays up to five hours in securing gas with all the frayed tempers and economic loss that this causes. The revolution in Iran has contributed to this. The communist conquest of distant Cuba has been a triumph for the Soviet Union despite the fact that it costs that country \$6 million per day.

May I enumerate a few of the reasons why U.S. citizens must be concerned about what is happening overseas?

1. The U.S.A. is dependent economically and militarily upon materials that must be imported. Oil and strategic minerals are familiar examples.
2. Numerous aircraft arrive every day from all round the world. These aircraft could carry diseases, terrorists, saboteurs or deadly toxins.
3. Hostile propaganda can be distributed through the mails or broadcast over the airways without restraint.
4. Jesus gave his followers the Great Commission, "Go into all the world and preach the Gospel." Communist conquest prevents obedience to this command of Christ.
5. The communist program to conquer the U.S.A. is expressed by the formula: "External Encirclement, plus Internal Demoralization, plus Thermonuclear Blackmail, leads to Progressive Surrender." Communism must be met and defeated on both the internal and external fronts.

We welcome gifts for specific purposes and spend the entire gift as the donor requests. Those who wish their gift to be spent within the U.S.A. need only say so. The communists are waging worldwide war. Please send the ammunition to combat them.
