Dear Friend,

It is an old, old story; the communists profess to be materialists, yet they are conquering the world by the dissemination of ideas; whereas the western world, which professes to believe in the supremacy of ideas and ideals, attempts to combat them by material means.

From every corner of the world, we receive frantic pleas: "Send us literature. Attractive communist literature is abundant and we have little or nothing with which to combat them."

Consider this letter from a young man studying in Nigeria:

"Before I received your books and newsletters, I received four books on communism from a Russian Professor whose address I found in a communist magazine circulated in Nigeria.

"Many Africans, including very prominent ones, have very vague ideas about communism. They have the idea that communism is common ownership of things, including women, by the state. Some even think that if Brezhnev alights from a car, any other individual can just take the car and drive it wherever he wants to go. The attitude of African Governments towards communism is based on such ignorance. They desire to prevent communism from overthrowing the government, but lack any means to immunize their youth against communism."
