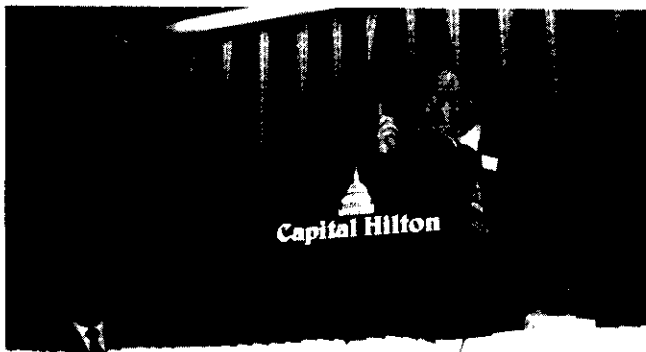
Dear Friend,

In our September 1 letter, I informed you of the two major financial blows the Crusade has received this year. One is that we have accepted responsibility for the debt of \$60,000 which our overseas colleague had incurred for printing and distributing 2 million copies of the book, "The Heart, Mind and Soul of Communism." This was a major battle in the war for the minds of 55 million, and we emerged victorious.

We are repaying the debt at the rate of \$5,000 each month and one-third of the debt has now been repaid. Our colleague writes: "Please permit me to thank you and the Board with a deep sense of gratitude for your most kind and gracious decision taken in helping me get out of this serious and grave situation."

Words are inadequate to express my gratitude to those of you who have made this possible by making a special gift. I plead with those of you who have not yet responded to do so immediately.

National Affairs Seminar

In September I attended and spoke at a National Affairs Seminar held in the Capital Hilton Hotel. The seminar was sponsored by the National Heritage Foundation and most of those attending were pastors of large evangelistic churches or directors of major television and radio network broadcasts. In one small gathering, when about 20 Christian broadcasters were meeting with a major presidential candidate, the leader of a Christian network T.V. show remarked: "The people in this room have access to a potential audience of 80 million." What awesome power!

Political leaders are awakening to the political power of Christian leaders. Consequently, many were willing and eager to speak to those assembled. This power must be used wisely and with restraint. Christian faith, however genuine, does not automatically confer political, economic, and technical wisdom on its possessor. This biblical instruction must be obeyed: "Add knowledge to your faith."

Soviet Combat Troops in Cuba

Neither the Soviet Union nor Cuba has made the slightest concession with regard to the presence of Soviet combat troops in Cuba. Castro will not even deny that they are combat troops. He merely affirms that they have been in Cuba for 17 years with the full knowledge of all U. S. Presidents. President Carter seems more concerned about the effect of their presence upon the Senate ratification vote on SALT II than upon their presence itself.

Each concession to the communists appears so reasonable. May God grant our leaders the wisdom to discern the dangers and the will to respond decisively, courageously, and effectively.
