A U.S. POL POT

He reminds me of Pol Pot, the butcher of Cambodia. Fortunately, he has not yet had Pol Pot's opportunity to translate words into deeds, but he is confident that his hour is coming. He exults that, when it does, the streets of America will run red with blood.

His name is Bob Avakian, and he is the Chairman of the Revolutionary Communist Party within the U.S.A. He is presently on a national lecture tour attempting to raise \$1 million to promote mass killing. A reporter, Bella Stumbo, from the LOS ANGELES TIMES attended a fund-raising rally, which he conducted in the Los Angeles Convention Center in August, and wrote a chilling description.

" 'How many of you would gladly smash that color TV of yours over the head of a pig in order to make revolution?' he screeched to a crowd of about 300 party faithful packed into an auditorium at the Convention Center earlier this month. A sea of eager hands immediately shot up. And that was only the beginning.

"By the time Avakian was finished, three hours later, most of his audience-- racially mixed, mostly under 30 and mostly blue-collar-- looked dazed or crazed, enough to rush out and at least hock the TV, along with their clothes and maybe their cars, in order to raise the \$1 million that Avakian told them the party needs.

"From there, it was back to killing that is going to be the necessary cost of it all. The masses must arm themselves and kill the slave masters.

" 'I mean, we won't kill some dumb jerk just because he jumped us for passing out our paper,' Avakian qualified. 'He can probably be reeducated. But it's another story with these hired thugs and killers, like the police... and the leaders of this country, like Mr. Carter!'

"The crowd cheered.

"Avakian ended with a shrill, chilling vision of masses of murderous workers, 'millions strong,' rushing through the streets of America, armed, shooting every 'bloodsucking, bootlicking capitalist' in sight."

Violent Arguments

The Revolutionary Communist Party is not satisfied to talk about violence; they practice it. They are frequently involved in bitter disputes with 'fraternal' communists and sometimes their logical instruments have been lead pipes and iron chains. Experience has taught them that when such an instrument is applied with adequate velocity to the skull of a dissenter, it produces a profound change in the point of view. The thought of what they would do if they had political power curdles the blood.

The Maximum Leader

Avakian has the typical background of the communist leader. He is the son of a Superior

Court Judge, and he embraced communism while he was a student of English literature at the University of California at Berkeley. It is the common story of the arrogant educated intellectual deceiving, enticing, and controlling a group of workers. His situation is similar to that of the Rev. Jim Jones, and it is probable that many of his followers would feed cyanide-laced Kool-Aid to their children and drink it themselves if he told them to do so. Consider these incidents as reported in the LOS ANGELES TIMES, August 19:

"After Avakian's speech, several party members rushed forward to pledge their loyalty.

"One emotion-choked postal worker rose to tell 'a beautiful story' about his 4-year-old daughter.

" 'The other day, she asked me why so many people were poor,' he said softly. 'So I told her, Because the capitalists take away their money. And do you know what she said?' He paused swallowing.

" 'She said, 'Then we should kill the capitalists.'

"That brought down the house. Several people vowed on the spot to pledge weekly or monthly donations in the name of their children.

"Some people had been so excited at the prospect of hearing Avakian in person that they brought their babies along.

" 'This dude is the greatest revolutionary leader alive. He is one dangerous cat--and I just wanted the kid to pick up his vibes,' explained one such parent, a bearded boy in blue jeans, wearing a feisty little worker's cap."

The Role of Money

Avakian seeks \$1 million. Money is a servant, and it will work for good or evil. The Crusade also needs money. In our September 1, 1979 letter, I shared the information that we had suffered from two severe financial blows that would cost us \$110,000. Firstly, we had lost \$50,000 due to the death of one of our longtime faithful supporters. He and others of his family have left a large Foundation, but the administration has changed and has ceased to support the Crusade. Secondly, one of our associates overseas had spent \$60,000 to print 2 million copies of the "Heart, Mind, and Soul of Communism" which were used successfully in a battle with the communists for control of 55 million people. We have accepted responsibility for the debt he incurred and are paying \$5,000 each month toward its liquidation.

Once again the friends of the Crusade are responding to the need and prospects are bright that our needs will be met. The campaign for special gifts must be sustained till Christmas. The danger is that some may grow weary in well-doing and relax. As the communist danger grows greater and draws nearer, extra effort is indicated.

Trapped in Vietnam

The communist danger is not academic to our friend and employee, Hoang Van Sao. His family attempted to leave Vietnam and failed. His daughter has written to him, and I am reprinting part of her letter with the hope that you will sense the spirit of love in the translation:

"Mother has been very sad; this has made her sick all the time. She looks very old now. The more I see her sadness, the more I love her. I pray every night that I may receive all of her suffering.

"Now we have no house, and we are not on the list of people who can buy food. What do we do now, Daddy? You are so far from us. I miss you so much.

"Do you know how old I am now? I am 20 years old. When you were home I was surrounded by the love of you and mom. I was really just a kid. I'm not a kid anymore. I hope that some day our family will be united.

"Your daughter, Ho-Thi-Hanh."

Pray with us that some way will be found to reunite Sao and his family.

The Pope and Fidel Castro

The visit of Fidel Castro, in his capacity as Chairman of the Non-Aligned Nations, has followed closely upon that of Pope John Paul II. What a contrast in personality and message. Pope John Paul II personified love and reconciliation; Fidel Castro personified class warfare.

Joseph Stalin once asked with a sneer. "How many divisions does the Pope have?" He was answered when the millions came to applaud the Pope's message and to express their love for him in Poland, Ireland, and the U.S.A. The press tried hard to focus attention on protests to the Pope's policies on priestly celibacy and the role of women in the church, but the millions loved and honored him. There is a hunger in the hearts of men and women for trustworthy authority and a willingness to sacrifice when challenged to do so for a worthy cause.

The Castro Lie

The visit of Fidel Castro was founded upon a lie. It is hilariously absurd that he should be chairman of the non-aligned nations when Cuba is aligned so closely with the Soviet Union. Russia pays Cuba a salary of \$8 million per day and Cuban troops are serving Russia in many parts of the world. It would be as appropriate to have Hitler as patron saint of the Society of Racial Equality.

The speech of Castro at the United Nations dripped hypocrisy. He said, "I speak on behalf of the children of the world who do not have a piece of bread," while he continues to support the Soviet Union which is taking the bread out of the mouths of the children. This year the Soviet Union is taking 25 million tons of grain from the U.S.A. If the communists would liberate the initiative and energy of the Russian people, they would be able to feed themselves and to supply food to many others throughout the world as the U.S.A. does. Instead of investing in an increased production of food, the communists have invested their resources in massive armaments and worldwide subversion.

Millions of children throughout the world are certainly suffering. They are murdered by abortionists, neglected by alcoholic, drug-crazed and self-indulgent parents, sexually exploited by the devotees of secular humanism, and robbed of the opportunity to hear the message of Christ by communists. Christians must reaffirm the priority of their devotion to children.

My foster son, Dr. John Whitehall, is engaged in practical work on behalf of needy children. He came to the U.S.A. in March to represent my children at our Silver Jubilee Banquet, and his message touched the hearts of all present. While here, he conceived the idea of organizing a "Total Child Care Conference" in Sydney, utilizing the service of U.S. experts on abused children. The conference was held at Macquarie University, Sydney, in September and was an outstanding success. An editorial, which appeared in the September 29 edition of Sydney's leading newspaper, THE SYDNEY MORNING HERALD, is reprinted at the end of this letter.

Camouflaged Surrender

The preferred method by which the Soviets propose to conquer this country is gradual or progressive surrender. The progress the communists have made towards their objective

is summed up in an article captioned, "A New Soviet Strategy", by Frances Fukuyama, published in the October edition of the prestigious magazine, COMMENTARY:

"Over the past two decades there has occurred in this country what might be called a slow process of self-Finlandization, whereby our expectations as to what constitutes normal or acceptable Soviet behavior in the world have steadily risen, while our view of our own sphere of legitimate action has continuously shrunk." (Page 58)

As Shakespeare said, "That thing we call a rose, by any other name would smell as sweet," and the consequences of surrender, by whatever name it may be called, are just as deadly. Surrender must be recognized, identified, and resisted.

Children's defender

JOHN WHITEHALL is a pediatrician. Since he graduated from Sydney University 13 years ago, he has cared for children in many parts of the world. As president and founder of the Society for International Aid, he led a team to Vietnam where he treated war refugees in many parts of the country. He has also worked with aid teams in Guam, Africa and East Timor. In 1977 the bitter fighting in Lebanon prompted him to recruit a team of nurses and physiotherapists to go as volunteers to the staff-depleted hospitals of Beirut. Dr Whitehall took his wife and five young children to Beirut, where they lived on an allowance of only \$50 a week in the midst of bombings and bloodshed.

Now Dr Whitehall's battleground is

here in Sydney. He returned from treating the small victims of war in Lebanon to confront a different kind of child victim, in his own practice in Sydney's Western Suburbs. They are the victims of child abuse and child pornography. At a press conference this week he said that more than 30 cases of suspected child abuse had recently been brought to his attention. He is appalled by the high incidence of child abuse and concerned both for the children and the disturbed adults who commit the violence. For the child pornographers he has no concern or sympathy.

He became involved in the fight against child pornography a year ago after confirming for himself the many stories about its ready availability. He did not have to go far. Even a local bookshop stocked glossy magazines full of lurid photographs and explicit articles, all featuring children. In Kings Cross he found that publications

which specialised in child pornography were available in about two-thirds of the bookshops he investigated. He has evidence to suggest that some of it is produced here. Wherever it originates, children are being ruthlessly exploited, damaged mentally and physically for fast and massive profit.

Dr Whitehall has the support of the police and the co-operation of the Printing and Kindred Industries' Union, which black bans the production of all child pornography. Unfortunately, high profit activities can usually afford to buy non-union labour and to evade the law. Dr Whitehall hopes that by raising public awareness of the extent and gravity of the problem he will muster more support for his fight. We hope he can. If the iniquity of child pornography cannot be eradicated, then the Year of the Child and "Care for Kids" will have been nothing but posturing and words.
