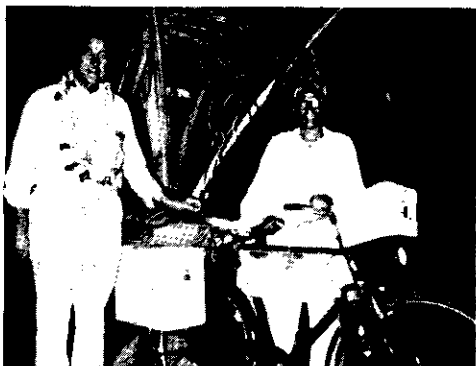
Dear Friend,

On Sunday, October 7, I was the guest of the First Baptist Church of Ft. Smith, Arkansas and its Pastor, Dr. Bill Bennett. I spoke to adult bible classes with over 1300 in attendance and at the morning and evening services.

Pastor Bennett asked me to answer the following questions:

1. What is the Communist program for the conquest of the U.S.?
2. How has Communism infiltrated the churches?
3. What are the facts of Soviet military strength compared to that of the U.S.?
4. Is SALT II in our interest?
5. What is the relationship between secular humanism and Communism?
6. In abolishing the draft, did we adopt one of the Communist policies for taking over a nation?
7. Why does Communism appeal to millionaires, college professors and ministers of religion?
8. Does President Carter really understand the Communist threat?
9. What about the tri-lateral commission?
10. Why should and how can Christians oppose Communism?
11. Are our public schools being used as tools for the Communists?
12. Is Cuba being prepared as a base from which the U.S. can be attacked?

Must free men cooperate with those who announce they are organizing to kill freedom and its advocates? Would the Nazi Party be permitted to rent the Convention Center?

I wish you could read the mail we receive daily from all round the world. The general theme is, *"The communists, aided by superbly produced literature, are threatening to conquer our country. Help us defeat them."*

I plead with you to send your gifts to enable us to respond effectively to these pleas.
