Dear Friends:

Running a literature program has been part of the FOR's work for most of its 60 years, but during the last decade we've taken an economic beating with it, largely because of the continuing emerging of the Indochina War. We've felt obliged to give away thousands of dollars worth of published items--from posters and buttons to pamphlets and books. I say "give away." What I mean is that we've simply thrown out, year after year, sizable stacks of bills owed by small local groups and individual peace workers.

Unfortunately, we're now at the point of either having to make the literature project self-supporting or to cut it back to a tiny operation that uses only FOR-published materials.

We don't want to do the latter. There really is a need, we're convinced, for a mail order publications project that serves the needs of people working for nonviolent social change.


Hence this letter: Please look over the enclosed list to see if we have anything of use for you.
