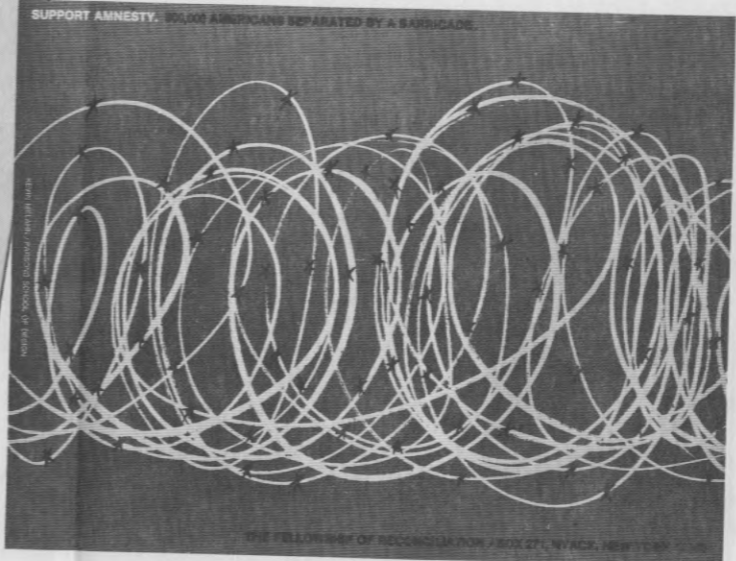

From Vietnam, a celebration of simplicity of life . . .

The woodcut, showing the cycle of the rice harvest and family life, is typical of the popular art that has been sold for centuries in Vietnamese marketplaces. The inscription means, "Good harvest". The Fellowship publishes this design to help in supporting the nonviolent peacemaking efforts of the School of Youth for Social Service in Vietnam, an indigenous Vietnamese effort to rebuild, renew cultural roots and encourage reconciliation.

"No room in the inn . . ."

This dawn-centered nativity reproduced in photo-lithography, is among the wood engravings of the late Eric Gill, renowned and beloved English pacifist, religious teacher and artist. The ancient Latin text beneath the design is the familiar "Peace on earth..." Inside are several lines from a nativity meditation by Thomas Merton:

Into this world, this demented Inn, in which there is absolutely no room for Him at all, Christ comes uninvited.

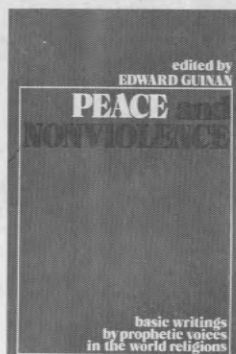

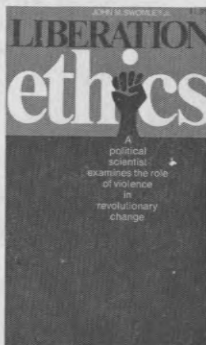

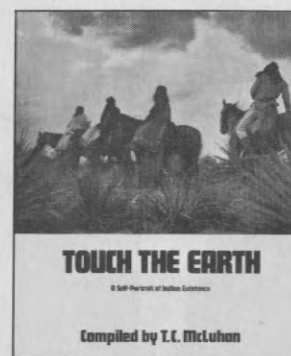
