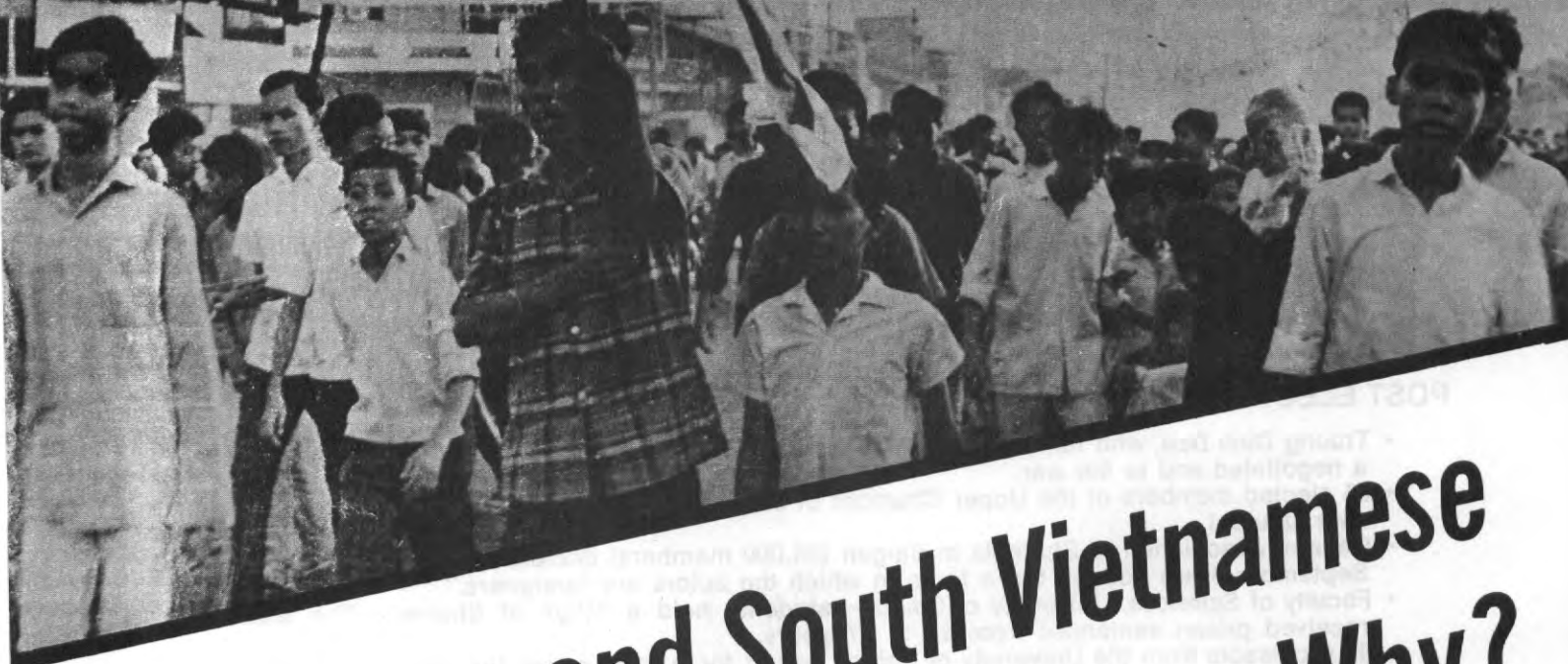

"FREE" ELECTIONS IN SOUTH VIETNAM?—September 3, 1967

- Tran Van Van, potential candidate for President, assassinated.
- Candidates General Duong Van Minh and three-time cabinet minister Au Truong Thanh barred.
- The government allowed only "reliable" people to vote. Neutrals and pro-peace people denied the vote.
- Newspapers not supporting the Thieu/Ky ticket censored or banned.

POST ELECTION PROTESTS CONTINUE

- Truong Dinh Dzu, who ran second to Thieu, sentenced to 5 years at hard labor for asking for a negotiated end to the war.
- 25 elected members of the Upper Chamber of the National Assembly denounced the elections as fraudulent.
- General Association of Students in Saigon (25,000 members) declared "the elections of September 3 are nothing but a farce in which the actors are foreigners."
- Faculty of Sciences, University of Saigon—students held a "Vigil of Shame"—The leaders received prison sentences from 22 to 27 years.
- 65 professors from the University of Saigon asked for a total cease fire. Many arrested and imprisoned.
- Thich Tri Quang and other Buddhist leaders as well as Roman Catholics, Cao Daoists and other religious leaders harassed, arrested, and imprisoned for peace activities.

There are "at least 20,000" political prisoners in South Vietnam—Thich Nhat Hanh, South Vietnam Buddhist Monk

VOTE FOR THE POLICY YOU WANT BY DEMANDING THAT THE UNITED STATES

- *acknowledge the fraudulence of 1967 election in South Vietnam*
- *remove its support of the Thieu Ky government*
- *end bombing of North Vietnam unconditionally*
- *recognize the NLF as a major party to any negotiations*
- *begin withdrawal of all military forces from South Vietnam immediately*
