A film is currently being produced on the political prisoners in South Vietnam which needs your help. The film (16mm black and white) is based on footage of two french teachers recently released from Chi Hua prison in Saigon. The two men, Andres Menras and Jean-Pierre Debris spent two and one half years in prison for demonstrating against the war in Saigon. The film has already gone into debt but financial help has been offered under the condition that the film-makers demonstrate that a demand for the film exists. Our funders have asked us to supply fifty-five letters within a one week period which ends next Wednesday April 11 from individuals and organisations who would like to organise at least one showing of the film.
