## THIS IS THE OPPOSITION

The John Birch Society airs its views with its Alan Stang Report on 80 Stations.

The Liberty Lobby, an extremist anti-Semitic group, broadcasts over 314 stations each day.

Dr. Carl McIntire's Twentieth Century Reformation Hour boasts that it reaches 7,000,000 listeners.

America's Future, voiced by R.K. Scott, is carried by 150 stations daily.

Clarence Manion, a founding father of the National Council of the John Birch Society, produces a weekly series of commentaries carried by 83 stations and airs his views daily.

E.W. Burpo's Bible Institute of the Air, broadcasting from Mesa, Arizona, has reported annual expenditures of \$510,000, almost all of it for broadcasting over 46 stations.

Dr. W.S. McBirnie's "Voice of Americanism" is aired daily on 100 stations.

Dr. Billy James Hargis's Christian Crusade in Tulsa has 100 broadcasts weekly.

Ronald Reagan's commentaries are carried by 250 stations. Earl Butz airs his views on 60 stations.

In all, some 10,000 right-wing broadcasts crowd our country's airwaves each week.

To counteract the onslaught of right-wing broadcasting, The Fund for Peace, through IPI, has developed a strong, effective voice to inform the American Public.

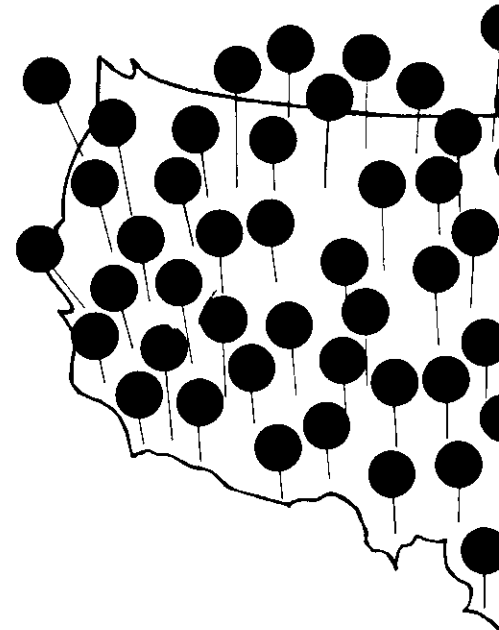

## IPI IS CONFRONTING THE OPPOSITION

IPI provides accurate, up-to-date, often exclusive information and analysis on current events at no charge to radio stations and newspapers throughout the fifty states.

Information is gathered by the investigative scholarship of the three research centers of The Fund for Peace—

The Center for Defense Information,

The Center for National Security Studies,

The Center for International Policy

—as well as the studies of its university fellows, the results of its seminars and conferences, and a wide range of other sources.

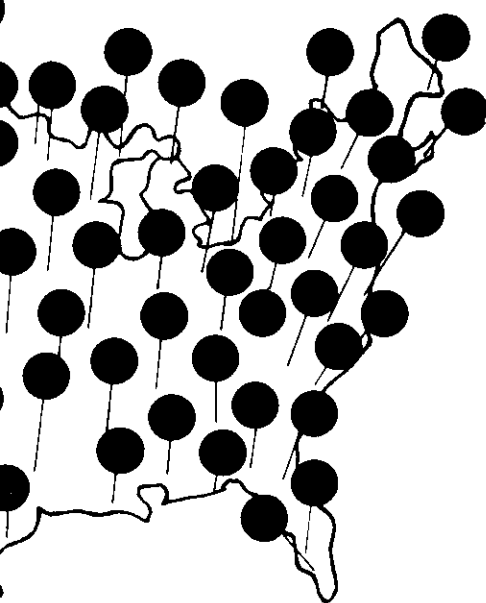
**IPI RADIO NETWORK**—Is a nationally syndicated daily documentary carried by 330 radio stations in fifty states with over five million listeners. Six 4-minute recorded commentaries a week are sent to each radio station.

**IPI PRESS SERVICE**—Is a syndicated column subscribed to by newspapers throughout the country. Six columns are sent out monthly typeset and ready to print.

Together the IPI Radio Network and Press Service are challenging the 10,000 right-wing radio programs every week. In some sections of the country the right-wing ideology monopolizes the airwaves, spewing hate, bigotry, and outrageous misinformation.

Today IPI is reaching 5,000,000 people with alternate points of view as an educational service of The Fund for Peace.
