- New styles of roles & relationships in other cultures

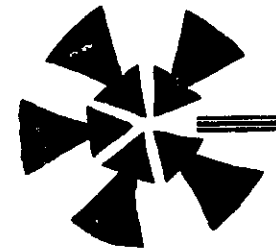
LEADERSHIP TRAINING FOR LIBERATION

interaction is a coalition of 5 organizations joined to coordinate efforts toward social justice and social transformation.

interaction is located in Washington, D.C., in two large houses which serve as offices, staff headquarters and Workshop Center for the coalition. Workshops may be held at this Center for reasonable rates or in your own community... anywhere in the country.

interaction uses a Workshop Methodology which the coalition has developed over an 18-month period, working with more than 450 persons from both religious and secular life.

===== SOCIAL CHANGE

Third World Consciousness

Today's greatest paradox is that the "advanced" world has a distorted view of other cultures and of change. It sees development almost solely as material instead of human growth and the goal of society as "stability" instead of creative change. Our Third World information and analysis give workshop participants a cross-cultural awareness which both critiques such a static philosophy as well as proving social consciousness for transforming society.

Dialogue-Reflection-Action Method

Based on the pedagogy of Paulo Freire, our Workshop Methodology links the socio-cultural backgrounds of people to their economic and political setting to engender action. The result is not only new and dynamic interpersonal relationships but inter-action between people and society.

Interaction Workshops As Process

Models Our agendas are worked out ahead of time through interaction between coordinators and participants in each case, because social change can occur only in dialogue

with participants in relation to their local realities. In this way, the Workshops become a process model of what should happen when concerned groups begin to interact with the wider society and other organizations and systems in their area. The result is corporate solidarity for creative social change..
