

THE THIRD WORLD

The French colonialists, around World War II, conceived of the First World as the US and its allies and the Second World as the Soviet Union and East Europe. The THIRD WORLD was seen as the "non-aligned," non-industrialized, "underdeveloped" countries of Asia, Africa, and Latin America.

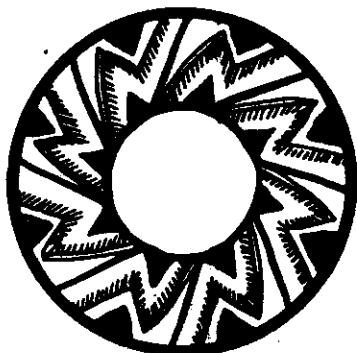
In recent years, the THIRD WORLD has also come to include those groups of people who are not geographically THIRD WORLD but who are exploited e.g. American Indians, Blacks, Appalachian whites, Chicanos, among others.

Still more recently, others have begun to include themselves as THIRD WORLD people because they too have been oppressed or have come to identify themselves with the other THIRD WORLD groups. These people include women, youth, gay people, and those in solidarity with the oppressed masses throughout the globe.

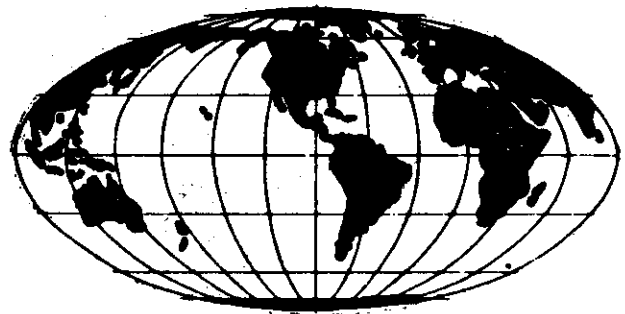
