Attached is the list of all the articles reprinted by the Third World Reader Service during 1971 and 1972.

As added services we offer the following ways of expanding your use of the reprints:

1. Individual copies of any article are available unless marked N.A.R. Instructions on how to order a reprint are on the last page of the index.
2. The entire "bank" of articles reprinted during 1971 may be purchased for \$20. The "bank" of articles reprinted in 1972 can be obtained for \$35. This is especially helpful for a person or group taking the SERVICE for the first time. Individual subscribers may purchase the approximately 80 articles which they did not receive from the last year, for \$20 (1972) and \$12 (1971). We will pay postage on both of these orders.
3. Bulk orders of articles may be purchased at the rate of 5¢ a sheet, total cost arrived at multiplying the pages listed by \$.05 and then by number of articles wanted. On orders over \$25, we will pay the postage.
4. For workshops and conferences we can prepare packets of 3-5 articles on specific topics. These usually run \$1.00 each.
5. Duplicate packets of the articles mailed in any one month are available as follows: Individual packet--\$1; Institution packet--\$4.
6. Group subscription rates are available to groups such as a congregation, office staff, or religious community who take a minimum of 6 subscriptions; one subscription, either institutional or Individual, at the regular price of \$75 or \$18, the additional 5 or more (usually Individual subscriptions) at \$12 a year. The entire group subscription will be mailed to one address in a single envelope.
7. Airmail rate for overseas Individual subscription is \$15 added to the \$18 subscription; for Institution subscription, \$25 added to the \$75 subscription.

Each article has been given a number which precedes the title of the article. Also listed, at the right side of the page, is the number of pages in the article. Since each page is 5¢, you will be able to calculate the cost of each article you wish to order.
