# What is ISI?

**T**HE INTERCOLLEGIATE STUDIES INSTITUTE was founded in 1953 by citizens deeply concerned about the preservation and extension of individual liberty. A non-profit, non-partisan, educational organization, ISI believes that freedom in any society is diminished or extended according to the quality and scope of the education of the individual. This education ought to nurture the broad knowledge and understanding essential for good judgement. Traditionally this has been accomplished through a liberal arts education, which involves an understanding of the principles of various disciplines, as they have been gleaned from Western thought and experience. ISI believes that a lack of this proper education leaves men prey to panaceas which offer utopia but inevitably lead to despotism. Hence the ISI motto: "To Educate for Liberty."

The Institute seeks to assist the American college student in apprehending the values free men must possess. Thus, through its programs ISI attempts to provide the student with sound scholarship in the various disciplines in order to help him obtain that education necessary to good citizenship, the preservation of liberty, and the humane life.

ISI membership is available at no charge to any college student or professor, and enables one to participate in the programs listed below.

## ISI Programs

**PUBLICATIONS** — ISI student and faculty members receive *The Intercollegiate Review* free of charge. The *Review* attempts to foster an understanding of the norms in each of the disciplines necessary to make competent judgements on issues vital to the attainment and preservation of freedom. The ISI Publications Program also encompasses *IR Reprints*, *The Academic Reviewer* and *The Political Science Reviewer*.

**LECTURE BUREAU** — ISI assists its associated study groups, campus representatives and faculty associates in bringing ISI speakers to the campus.

**CAMPUS REPRESENTATIVES** — ISI campus representatives work with ISI Regional Directors in presenting the ISI alternative on campus.

**FACULTY ASSOCIATES** — ISI faculty associates help bring ISI to a wider audience by assisting the local campus representative in bringing ISI lectures to campus, by advising ISI study groups, and by recommending top students for Weaver Fellowship.

**ASSOCIATED STUDY GROUPS** — ISI study groups are assisted by the Institute and speakers are occasionally provided. These campus groups have "To Educate for Liberty" as their common objective.

**SEMINARS** — One- and two-day ISI seminars examine such topics as *The Continuing Crisis in Higher Education*, *Academic Freedom and Student Power*, and *Man and Property* at no charge to participants.

**RICHARD M. WEAVER FELLOWSHIP AWARDS PROGRAM** — Approximately 25 fellowships are awarded every year for graduate study. The Weaver Fellow receives a \$2,000 grant and payment of tuition at the school of his choice.

**SPECIAL BOOK OFFERS** — Important works are made available to ISI members at greatly reduced rates. *Witness*, *The Conservative Mind*, and *The Road to Serfdom* are among the scores of titles that have been offered at discounts ranging up to 90%.

**TAPE CASSETTE LIBRARY** — ISI makes available, on loan or for your purchase at cost, the cassette tapes of the best ISI lectures.

**ISI ALUMNI ASSOCIATION** — Membership is open to everyone outside the academic community who would like to continue to receive ISI materials, participate in ISI programs, and assist ISI in its work on the campus. Activities include a resume service, special alumni conferences, book offers, and newsletter.

**SUMMER SCHOOLS** — Four annual week-long ISI Summer Schools each accepts up to 80 students.
