SOUTH AFRICA: FIGHT FOR FREEDOM

White minority rule in South Africa is under attack. Tens of thousands of workers and students are saying NO to apartheid. Apartheid means that blacks in South Africa - the workers who create the wealth enjoyed by the white rulers - HAVE NO RIGHTS - no votes, no unions. Blacks live in separate towns and they cannot own property. The blacks in South Africa are kept in conditions of slavery by the white bosses who want complete control over the workforce. But students and workers are uniting to use their power to fight back: massive strikes have nearly shut down industry in Johannesburg and other major cities.
