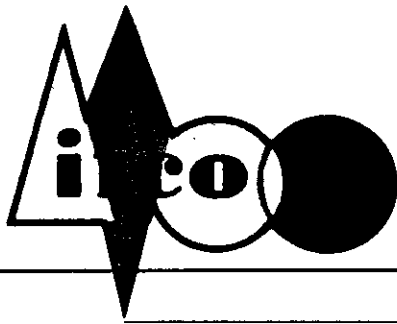

The people at Wounded Knee have asked us to raise money to help do the legal work for a Treaty Rights hearing before the Senate Foreign Relations Committee.

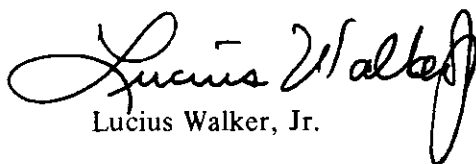
A coalition of five Native American legal organizations has joined together to do the work on this most urgent issue in Washington.
