Whether you tend to support liberals or conservatives, you'll probably agree that the politics of today are a disaster. The Left hungers for ever-larger economic controls, taxes, and subsidies for its social welfare schemes, while the Right seethes with a compulsion to police the world abroad, and regulate our personal conduct at home.

The Libertarian Party was formed to offer that choice — to challenge the cult of the omnipotent State, and to defend the rights of the individual.

The Libertarian Party, alone among America's political parties, holds that you, and you alone, have the right to exercise sole dominion over your own life, so long as you do not forcibly interfere with the same right of others.

Everyone who joins the Libertarian Party is required to sign a pledge against the initiation of physical force as a means of achieving social and political goals. And all candidates who seek to run on the LP label agree to abide by the Party's Statement of Principles. If they break this promise, they will be repudiated by the Party. For the Libertarian Party is a party of principle; we will not change our tune simply to win votes or please pressure-groups.

If you are looking for a party that will not betray you, that will stand uncompromisingly for your rights as an individual — if you believe that you are capable of running your own life, and don't need to have others run it for you— then you will find what you seek in the Libertarian Party.

WHERE THE LP STANDS ON THE ISSUES

TAXATION — The LP's National Platform calls for "an immediate reduction of both taxes and government spending," with the long-range goal of eliminating all taxation, starting with the repeal of the Federal Personal Income Tax.

REGULATION — The LP advocates the elimination of wage/price controls, restrictions on free trade, and all government intervention into relations between employers and unions.

INFLATION — The LP favors an immediate and permanent end to deficit spending, repeal of laws prohibiting American citizens from owning gold, and the elimination of the Federal Reserve System, which creates paper money without backing or limit, thus watering down the purchasing power of everyone's earnings.

DOMINATION — The LP is opposed to "no knock" laws, censorship, busing, conscription, laws against private sexual conduct and drug use, and all forms of government spying on American citizens.

MANIPULATION — The LP opposes any commitment of U. S. citizens to combat on foreign soil, and any involvement in international programs, treaties, or organizations which trap U. S. citizens into financial support of other countries or surrender U.S. sovereignty to any foreign power, national or international.
