Dear Friend:

It is strange that, in the midst of the calamities of 1971, the instruments for the restoration of liberty and the Constitution were being put together.

And 1971 was indeed a year of calamities. All governmental pretense of economy was thrown to the winds. The largest deficits in history now loom. The dollar lost value everywhere.
