Dear Friend:

The projection of things to come contained in the January REPORT ON FREEDOM fell far short of the realities that already loom, just one month later. The drive for the LIBERTY AMENDMENT is climbing wonderfully. We want to keep it that way, as I am sure you do too.

In this field of action, it is good to note that our Resolution, already approved by 7 states, either has been or soon will be introduced before the Legislatures of 30 states, with strong leadership and swiftly mounting public support involved in each state.

The IRS case is being reshaped to be refiled in the District Court in Los Angeles. The State case, which is parallel to it, is headed toward the Superior Court of California. Both are tremendously essential elements in this fight for liberty, and both are expensive, needing your help.

The underwriting of books (WHERE THE MONEY WENT) to libraries (tax exempt to donors) is strongly renewed after a lag over the holidays. The distribution of the cassette taped meetings titled LET'S HAVE A MEETING progresses steadily, and with spectacular impact wherever it is used. The new project of developing a powerhouse classroom lesson series for high schools and colleges on the CONSTITUTION has already won extraordinary acceptance, with only one pilot tape in existence. Hear what Dr. W. Cleon Skousen, Professor at Brigham Young University, as well as founder and President of FREEMEN INSTITUTE, Salt Lake City, has to say:

"I have just heard the tape and it is just magnificent--exactly what we have been waiting for. How soon can we expect the full set...? I can't tell you how thrilled I am with this."
