## COMMUNIST MANIFESTO

Here from the COMMUNIST MANIFESTO are the definitive terms designed to dehumanize people, strip them of their God-given rights and deprive them of property, liberty and life itself through the despotism of concentrated power.

1. Abolition of property in land and application of all rents to public purposes.
2. A heavy **progressive or graduated income tax**.
3. Abolition of all right of inheritance.
4. Confiscation of the property of all emigrants and rebels.
5. Centralization of credit in the hands of the State, by means of a national bank with State capital and an exclusive monopoly.
6. Centralization of the means of communication and transport in the hands of the State.
7. Extension of factories and instruments of production owned by the State, the bringing into cultivation of waste lands, and the improvement of the soil generally in accordance with a common plan.
8. Equal liability of all to labor. Establishment of industrial armies, especially for agriculture.
9. Combination of agriculture with manufacturing industries; gradual abolition of the distinction between town and country, by a more equitable distribution of population over the country.
10. Free education for all children in public schools. Abolition of children's factory labor in its present form. Combination of education with industrial production, etc., etc.

## THE BILL OF RIGHTS

### FROM THE U.S. CONSTITUTION

The BILL OF RIGHTS provides "further declaratory and restrictive clauses" to the Constitution "to prevent misconstruction or abuse of its powers." Here they are:

- Amendment #1:** Congress shall make no law respecting religion or freedom of speech, press, right of assembly and for a redress of grievances.
- Amendment #2:** A well regulated militia and the right of people to keep and bear arms.
- Amendment #3:** No soldier shall be quartered in any house without owners consent.
- Amendment #4:** A person and his papers and effects secure against search and seizure and warrants issued under oath describing place to search and persons or things to be seized.
- Amendment #5:** No person held for capital crime until indicted or tried twice for same offense, or testify against himself, or be deprived of life, liberty or property without due process of law or property taken without just compensation.
- Amendment #6:** The right to a speedy and public trial by jury, and the accused fully informed and confronted by accusers with right to witnesses and counsel for his defense.
- Amendment #7:** The right of trial by jury is preserved, and no fact examined by a jury shall be re-examined except under rules of common law.
- Amendment #8:** Excessive bail shall not be required, nor excessive fines imposed, nor cruel and unusual punishments inflicted.
- Amendment #9:** The enumeration in the Constitution, of certain rights, shall not be construed to deny or disparage others retained by the people.
- Amendment #10:** The powers not delegated to the United States by the Constitution, nor prohibited by it to the States, are reserved to the States respectively, or to the people.

# RESOLUTION

**WHEREAS:** America's greatness is the product of rigid Constitutional law that provides freedom from arbitrary governmental interference, and

**WHEREAS:** Violations of this principle have produced hundreds of federal corporate activities now competing with the private enterprises of the American people, and

**WHEREAS:** These federal corporate activities have taken over 40% of the land area and 20% of the industrial capacity of the nation, and require more than half the federal revenue to pay their losses and hidden costs, and

**WHEREAS:** The purpose of the Ninth and Tenth Amendments to the Constitution was to limit the government to the specific activities delegated to it by the Constitution, and

**WHEREAS:** The Fifth Article of the Constitution provides that the people can exercise their rights to a redress of grievances through an amendment requiring concurrence of  $\frac{2}{3}$  of the members of both Houses of Congress, or by the application of the Legislatures of  $\frac{2}{3}$  of the several states, and in either case, ratification by  $\frac{3}{4}$  of the States;

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** that we, the members of \_\_\_\_\_

\_\_\_\_\_ to preserve and fortify the intent and purposes of the Constitution by submitting to the people for ratification the LIBERTY AMENDMENT to the Constitution, now pending in Congress as H.J. Res. 23, and already approved by Wyoming, Texas, Nevada, Louisiana, Georgia, South Carolina and Mississippi, which provides that:

**"Sec. 1.** The Government of the United States shall not engage in any business, professional, commercial, financial or industrial enterprise except as specified in the Constitution.

**"Sec. 2.** The constitution or laws of any State, or the laws of the United States shall not be subject to the terms of any foreign or domestic agreement which would abrogate this amendment.

**"Sec. 3.** The activities of the United States Government which violate the intent and

purposes of this amendment shall, within a period of three years from the date of the ratification of this amendment, be liquidated and the properties and facilities affected shall be sold.

**"Sec. 4.** Three years after the ratification of this amendment the sixteenth article of amendments to the Constitution of the United States shall stand repealed and thereafter Congress shall not levy taxes on personal incomes, estates, and/or gifts."

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that a copy of this Resolution be included in the minutes of this meeting, and that certified copies of it be sent to (1) the members of both Houses of Congress from this State, (2) the members of the Legislature of this State, (3) to newspapers and other media that others may know of this action and may emulate it, and (4) to the Liberty Amendment Committee of the U.S.A., 6413 Franklin Avenue, Los Angeles 28, California.
