Dear Friend and Fellow Member:

A friend recently said:

"HAVE YOU SEEN YOURSELF ON TELEVISION * AS A REFUGEE YET?"

That was a shocker. It made me stop and think--are the present fast growing series of events leading to the moment of take-over? The sequence of happenings sketched so briefly in the attached REPORT ON FREEDOM seem to indicate that they are.

But the idea of Americans being refugees! That is as far-fetched as can be--as far-fetched as the Hungarians once believed it to be, or the Cubans, or the Koreans, or the Vietnamese. A refugee is one who leaves, through force or desire, everything--EVERYTHING--just to find freedom and safety again.

History tells us it happens often, whenever a people refuses to find or apply a remedy to the ruthless reach for power. John Dickinson, delegate to the Constitutional Convention from Pennsylvania, put it very clearly some years before the Revolutionary War, when (in 1768) he said:

"Millions entertain no other idea of the legality of power, than that it is founded on the exercise of power. They voluntarily fastened their chains, by adopting the pusillanimous opinion 'that there will be too much danger in attempting a remedy.'"

We pray it will never happen here, but don't bet on it, unless we redouble our efforts to restore our Constitution to force and effect. That Constitution is our only citadel of freedom, and the LIBERTY AMENDMENT is the only instrument available capable of restoring our rights and protections. But this doesn't make it happen. Only you can do that.

It is urgent that each of us do everything within our power in the cause of Freedom. Recruit your friends; get meetings together to discuss what can be done in your area. We can help you do it, and we will. Together we can win. The American people are ready. Our job is to reach them. Please give your generous help to your National Committee to speed up the great Bi-Centennial program to regain liberty.
