WATERGATE * WATERGATE * WATERGATE! We hear little else these days, yet we know so little about it, or the vast oceans of political corruption behind it. The attached REPORT ON FREEDOM might give a glimpse behind the Watergate scene and expose a bit of the monumental grab for power and plunder at work.

Perhaps the revelations catch us by surprise, yet we must have known, all along, about this rottenness which threatens to destroy liberty and our private enterprise system utterly, if we let it run. Hopefully, the Watergate fiasco has given us some additional time, but the need for financing becomes even more critical. Please read the REPORT thoughtfully to envision the magnitude of the threats to liberty, and then do everything you can in the cause.
