1971 PROGRESS REPORT

Your LIBERTY LOBBY accomplished much last year:

1. GENOCIDE CONVENTION. Once again, thanks to you and other cooperating patriots and leaders throughout America, we were able to arouse the opposition to this nefarious scheme. On Apr. 23 we sent out EMERGENCY Liberty Letter No. 28. The result: Contrary to plan, the treaty was not brought out of the Senate Foreign Relations Committee for ratification because its backers realized it would be defeated if it were.

2. PANAMA CANAL. Your spirited reaction to our early exposure of the newest plan to give away the Canal resulted in our winning this first skirmish. The State Department had counted on total secrecy until it was too late for effective action, and of course America's controlled "free press" cooperated obediently. Our alert completely upset their timetable. Since Aug. 25--the date of our EMERGENCY Letter No. 29--the papers have been forced to give minimum publicity to the revolutionary plan. The main battles are ahead, but Round One has gone to US.

3. BILDERBERGERS. Our June Liberty Lowdown (No. 100)--sent monthly to all Board of Policy members--exposed the secret meeting of many of the world's most powerful men when they convened at Woodstock, Vt., Apr. 23-25, to plan more self-serving "changes in America's role" in world affairs. The "changes" plotted clandestinely at Woodstock appeared in view and were made official on Aug. 15, when Mr. Nixon devalued the dollar and proclaimed a "national emergency," and later, when he recognized Red China. NO IMPORTANT NEWSPAPER IN THE ENTIRE WORLD CARRIED THE WOODSTOCK STORY--THE BIGGEST STORY OF 1971--UNTIL OUR EXPOSURE FORCED THEM TO. But our members of the Board of Policy were the first to know.

4. TESTIMONY. Last year our representatives had the privilege of officially transmitting your thoughts and feelings to Congress 13 times on vital issues! We presented testimony or statements on these subjects:

5. OUR GOOD NAME. We have taken action against malicious libelers twice this year and have succeeded each time. As you recall, last year we forced True Magazine to run a truthful article in response to a smear, and we collected a cash settlement.

Early last year we concluded a satisfactory settlement with Rep. Harold Runnels (D-N.Mex.), who, in his 1970 campaign, repeated some falsehoods about LIBERTY LOBBY. Realizing his error, he inserted his apology and retraction in the Congressional Record on Apr. 1, 1971 (p. E2689).

We have also cooperated with the police in their efforts to get criminal indictments against persons who have harassed us by thievery, vandalism, perjury, and the mailing of poison-pen letters to many of our members and supporters. I am confident that when the facts are finally revealed concerning the subversive backing of these criminals, their basic motivation will become obvious even to those who prefer not to believe in the "conspiracy theory of history."

At this time we are also compelled to negotiate with another magazine in New York which ran a lengthy and lying hoax about LIBERTY LOBBY in its Sept. 10 issue. We are demanding satisfaction for this vicious smear. You will be hearing more about this matter shortly.

Instead of wasting our time trying to "explain" smears and justify ourselves to those who have no interest in the truth, we have simply continued our effective work, except, of course, that we always answer all questions from Board members. Thus, the aim of the enemy--to silence us--has failed. We have survived the smear barrage only because we have never retreated one inch.

The result of this policy is that LIBERTY LOBBY stands proudly in Washington like the Rock of Gibraltar, occupying our own building only a stone's throw from the Capitol--a permanent wedge driven deeply into territory controlled by the enemy. And remember this: LIBERTY LOBBY is the ONLY large political institution in Washington which is NOT controlled by the Council on Foreign Relations! And we expect to be here long after our detractors are fully exposed for what they are!

6. PEACE. As you are aware, LIBERTY LOBBY is America's only genuine peace group. Years ago, we were one of the few voices strongly opposed to getting involved in the no-win Vietnam war. Today, we are equally opposed to involvement in the Mideast, in spite of the hostility we have encountered because of our pro-American policy. LIBERTY LOBBY has successfully established and maintained its leadership in this delicate matter.

Although LIBERTY LOBBY is a political institution and not educational in nature, sometimes we find that education is necessary when others fail to deal courageously with controversial issues. Thus, early last year we decided to prepare an official document to explain America's historic foreign policy in the light of the constant pressures that are intent on driving us into a bloodbath in the Mideast. Our publication of America First met this critical need and has opened new vistas to many thousands of good Americans. America First is an outstanding document: historically truthful, philosophically pro-American, and religiously sound. It may save America from another useless, bloody war. If LIBERTY LOBBY had done nothing more in 1971 than publish America First, our existence on your behalf would have been more than justified.

7. BUSING. In early September we made an important decision--to enter the anti-forced busing, freedom of choice fight with all the resources we could muster. Since then, as reported in Liberty Letter, we have helped in the formation of ACTION NOW, a national federation of local groups, and we have assisted local leaders throughout the U.S. in setting up rallies and making their activity more effective. We have published the National Freedom of Choice News--an action-filled newspaper designed for the purpose of giving parents and taxpayers guidance in effectively fighting for freedom of choice and private schools. Every two weeks we publish a special newsletter which is sent free to all local leaders for the purpose of keeping them informed about developments in other sections of the Nation and advised on the progress of the Freedom from Forced Busing Amendment which, as I write, has received endorsement from 130 Congressmen, who have signed the discharge petition to bring it to the floor for a vote.

The great majority of all races oppose forced busing. Yet, the political establishment is totally committed to it. Thus, we have a great opportunity to break the stranglehold of the establishment, and this is exactly what we intend to do.

NOT ALL PEACHES AND CREAM

Please do not assume from this report that all is well. You know as well as I the vast dangers confronting America. I need not inform you that the overall situation is critical and is rapidly worsening. The amazing spectacle of a President--who was elected by conservatives--doing what no Democratic liberal before him would attempt to do--is sickening. Who told Richard Nixon to recognize Red China, legitimize Soviet conquests, accumulate the greatest peacetime deficit in history, impose price and wage controls, and proclaim a "national emergency"?

Forced integration of suburbia, our schools, armed forces, everywhere that the arm of the federal government can reach, is proceeding as rapidly as your tax money permits. Crime, slums, and pornography have never been so prevalent. Our defense (exactly as we have predicted for 10 years) is now second to the Soviet Union and our armed forces are gravely weakened. Nixon has placed an alien-born security risk named Henry Kissinger in command of national security, including all intelligence operations. A disaster of unimaginable proportions seems ahead.

Yet I feel privileged to head LIBERTY LOBBY during this time. Your support in the past has brought us through every crisis, and your decision today will affect your personal and national future. Our responsibility is vast, and I pray that you will give your closest attention to what I am now about to write.

IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENT OF CHANGE

Over the past weeks I have deliberated for many hours with my associates in LIBERTY LOBBY. Conditions in America are changing so rapidly that appropriate change is also demanded on our part. By "change," I do not mean that we should alter the basic principles of LIBERTY LOBBY, but make certain adjustments necessary to assure our future.

For example, the subscription price of Liberty Letter--two dollars per year--is small, yet for it we are obliged to prepare, print and mail twelve issues of a highly-informative legislative report to subscribers--and to do it without benefit of advertising, which normally supplies revenue for a publication. The deficit we have always had to make up from contributions and membership fees.

I feel that the true value of Liberty Letter is many times the modest subscription cost of \$2 per year. What other publication costs only \$2? Your local edition of America's monopoly-controlled "free press" costs you more per month than Liberty Letter costs per year. I know of financial newsletters costing \$100 and more which have given investment advice causing subscribers to lose fortunes. Early last year three of them confidently predicted that by July the Treasury would issue new currency. We knew better so did not print the

hysterical rumor. Liberty Letter has always been accurate in its facts and far more correct in its predictions than some publications costing a hundred fold more.

In addition to the above considerations, I am mindful of the misleading "Common Cause" group, Ralph Nader's group, and other so-called "citizen lobbies" in Washington which attempt to copy LIBERTY LOBBY in every respect except four: they all charge their members more, they all pay their employees more, they will not expose the Federal Reserve monetary fraud that finances communism, and they are all controlled by the Council on Foreign Relations. The next time you are asked for a contribution by some so-called "peoples' lobby," test them by these criteria!

Nevertheless, Common Cause now claims some 200,000 members, and their basic membership fee is \$15 per year. Yes, they have had enormous free publicity and promotion by the news media, but if people are willing to pay \$15 for a leftist front operating behind a facade that leads people to believe that it is in the public interest, then they should be willing to pay at least that much to join the real thing.

Thus, last month we asked the Board of Policy for advice. We mailed all Members a ballot, and asked them to decide between these two alternatives:

- (1) To increase the annual subscription price from \$2 to \$5 per year;
- (2) To increase it from \$2 to \$12 per year, and to include Liberty Lowdown as part of the bargain.

The response from our Board of Policy was immediate, and by the 20th of last month we had our result: The Board voted to increase the subscription price of Liberty Letter to \$5 per year. The increase was effective Jan. 1.


If you had been a full part of LIBERTY LOBBY last year as a Member of the of the Board of Policy I am sure that we would be able to report even more victories at this time.
