TIME FLIES by faster than a jet into the sunset, leaving but a trail of memories. One season slides into another. Christmas is just around the corner . . . but it's not too late to order books for Christmas if you do it immediately. Last year I had wonderful response from the books I gave. My (head in the sand) sister really enjoyed The Wartime Journals of Charles A. Lindbergh. Enclosed is our latest book list. If you wish us to send your gifts directly, you can enclose a card with your order. Time is slipping by, and I suggest you order by air mail.

SAFE AT LAST. In the Nation's capital where it is unlawful to have an unregistered gun, if you are not a criminal . . . and where crime is rampant . . . a person does not feel safe after dark without LANCE. In fact, I would not walk two blocks to my apartment after 5 p.m. without it. You may have read about LANCE by its technical name, orthochlorobenzalmalonotrile, "CS" for short. CS is truly a miracle of modern chemical science. Upon contact with the skin it produces extreme pain. This temporary pain is such that a would-be attacker (mugger, rapist, or assassin) instantly crumbles to the ground helpless. Yet LANCE is perfectly harmless and within 15 minutes (long enough to summon police) the crippling effects have passed--and no permanent harm is done! (This is important in view of liberal court decisions which have held law-abiding citizens liable for injuries to criminals).

Non-lethal LANCE is so powerful that it is used in Vietnam against the Viet Cong. It is used by police departments from coast to coast. In one case, a woman held off six attackers; in another, a man in Cleveland stopped an entire gang of 15 attackers, capturing seven of them, who cowered like kittens after one shot. The others--after seeing what happened when their confederates were "Lanced," ran away, never to return.

As a rule, LIBERTY LOBBY has not carried items other than educational and political; however, a number of our members have been attacked in the last few years. You are so good to us, I felt we should help protect you! Also, it is a

The complete unit sells for \$10; both units together, only \$12.

NIXON'S MANDATE. President Nixon has confided to close friends that he is preparing a package of controversial legislative proposals that he intends to dump on the new Congress abruptly when it convenes in January. He says he will push hard to get his programs enacted during the first 60 days of the legislative session while he is still basking in his second Presidential honeymoon before the opposition gets organized. Nixon will again stress the spirit of togetherness in a happy bipartisan approach to global problems.

Foremost on the Nixon agenda is speedy ratification of his U.S.-Soviet trade pact--with a minimum of debate on specifics. Since only the Senate has to ratify treaties, little opposition is expected from the internationalist-oriented Senators. However, opposition is anticipated against the still unannounced \$25 billion foreign aid program for all Indo China. This grandiose scheme includes regional hydro-electric and manufacturing development of the Mekong Valley and massive economic rehabilitation of both North and South Vietnam. This proposal will be ballyhooed as a "Marshall Plan" for Southeast Asia. Henry A. Kissinger has secured the tacit approval for the U.S. to take over the burden of supporting this impoverished and underdeveloped area. This fits the Grand Design of economic regionalization as a preliminary step toward world government.

ANTI-TERRORISM. President Nixon initiated an "anti-terrorism" program on Sept. 25 by issuing a directive establishing a Cabinet-level committee on terrorism. Its members represent the FBI, Central Intelligence Agency, the Attorney General, and the State, Defense, Treasury, and Transportation Departments. So far the program has been used to harrass, interrogate, jail, deport, and terrorize Arabs.

YEAR END REPORT. Colonel Dall has requested Rev. Stanley M. Andrews to prepare the Year End Report as his last official project for LIBERTY LOBBY before retiring. It will be mailed to Board members in about two weeks. I have read the first draft; it is very comprehensive and I know you will want to read every word of it the minute you receive it.

NEC. Remember in my October VIP letter I warned you about how the old National Economic Council had been taken over by a promoter who was using our stolen mailing list to solicit funds? Well, the promoter is Dorothy Denton, who has shifted tactics and is now operating as the "National Fund for a New Congress," and she is again using our stolen list! She signs the letters, "Henry Hilton."

SALUTE. A year ago a dedicated Board of Policy member moved to the Washington area so that she could become a full-time volunteer at LIBERTY LOBBY. Neither rain, sleet, snow, nor heat has kept her from her job. This kind and thoughtful grandmother of 11 has been tremendously helpful in our SAVE OUR SCHOOLS program, in the mail room, pledge department, or wherever else her talents could be used. It seems our slightest wish is her command. Lynda Lyons, I salute you!

MERRY CHRISTMAS! The entire staff at LIBERTY LOBBY wishes you an old fashioned Merry CHRISTmas! Many schools are demanding that Christ be taken out of Christmas.
