

OFFICIALS PERMIT DESTRUCTION OF NATION'S CAPITAL***Congress Must Investigate Top Officials***

The April riots made it perfectly clear that in a showdown between criminals and decent citizens, the Great Society backs up the criminals.

What this means for the future of law and order in America is alarming. The pattern of violence has now been established. **The road ahead leads to disaster.**

Rioting broke out in Washington at about 8 o'clock in the evening on Thursday, April 4. The initial police response, according to Director of Public Safety Patrick Murphy, was his own decision to pull policemen out of the area. Looting began immediately, and progressed faster than the police could be withdrawn. The result was the spectacle of policemen in the role of idle spectators watching wholesale robbery, theft and arson.

Police orders were to avoid force at all costs. The cost was high in the beginning, and steadily grew higher as each new block of homes and businesses was set afire.

Some officials urged that Federal troops be used to put down the riots before they grew worse. This was not reported by the press (including radio). In fact, practically nothing of significance was reported by the press except that the police had orders not to shoot. The effect of this news was to pour gasoline on the flames. On Friday the 5th, thousands of new rioters swarmed into the center of the city, defying the police.

Still, nothing was done to call out the troops. A great tower of smoke rose over the city. White people were hauled out of their automobiles on the streets and beaten unmercifully by the sometimes savage—sometimes laughing—mobs. The afternoon grew dark with smoke. Headlights were required for driving. Still the troops were not called out. "Someone" had decided that the time was not yet ripe.

This pattern of delay seems carefully planned by those who decided to let Washington burn. The officials who carried out the plan may have received their orders from someone else. If so, the people of the United States have a right—no, a **duty**—to find out from whom the orders came.

For instance, who pays Cyrus Vance, the untitled spokesman for President Johnson? Vance seems to have all of the (often wrong) answers, and took control of the entire Washington riot area, but no one can find out what his official position is.

Congressman John Rarick has called for an investigation of the conduct of those responsible. (See below.) Such an investigation **should** be conducted, and quickly.

**WHAT YOU CAN DO:**

- Write your representative, and urge him to support an investigation of the authorities responsible for the handling of the Washington riots.
- Tell him your opinion of the official policy of non-interference with criminals as carried out by the police and military.
- Ask him to find out why those in charge failed to call in military force for 20 hours after it had been officially decided that the police could not cope with the riots.
- Ask him if he would advocate a similar policy of "restraint" in the event of a riot or other disaster in his own congressional district.
- Write a Letter to the Editor of your newspaper, asking others to make their feelings known to your congressman.
- Urge your friends and relatives to write, also.
- Find out whether or not your own local authorities also have an official plan to allow arson and other crime rather than to arrest rioting criminals.

CONGRESS CHICKENS OUT

Strange, isn't it, how every civil rights bill is passed with a bullet?

Did you ever suspect that President Kennedy's assassination may have been ordered to get the then-pending civil rights bill through? Before he was killed, even his brother Bobby, the Attorney General, pleaded with House Judiciary Committee Chairman Emanuel Celler to weaken the bill, saying that otherwise it couldn't pass. Instead, Celler strengthened the bill, Jack Kennedy was conveniently killed by a Communist, and the bill went through on the mob hysteria whipped up by the "free press," which blamed the deed on hate mongers and segregationists.

Then, in 1965, the Voting Rights Bill was up. After Viola Liuzzo was killed, it went right through.

Now, as if by "coincidence," just as it looked as if the Forced Housing Civil Rights Bill was going to be defeated because of the efforts of thousands of alerted Americans, Martin King was killed. Obediently, the "free press" cooperated, and created the greatest

that this Nation has even seen. Intimidated by marauding bands of rioters and looters outside heavily-guarded windows and doors, the Congress trembled in its shoes and meekly capitulated to mob rule in the most disgusting display of Congressional fear and irresponsibility in American history.

By so doing, the members committed a double crime. For not only did they allow themselves to be intimidated, but they also slapped their constituents in the face. No one argues that the majority of the American people wanted this outrageous bill. *On the contrary, poll after poll shows that the voters are overwhelmingly opposed to forced housing!*

The real tragedy is yet to come. If any of the congressmen who bowed their necks to mob rule believe that passing the Forced Housing Civil Rights Bill will save them from the worry of further danger to their life and limb, and enable them to return to their easy and luxurious life at the public trough, they are in for a surprise. The bill was not even passed before demands for new concessions were being shrieked by the revolutionaries.

All history shows that you can't compromise with evil. Sooner or later, the music must be faced. Will the terrorized Congress stand up against the mobs now, or later? Or never?

The new demand is for twenty billion dollars from the taxpayers for housing and other Negro charity. If Congress submits again to the mob, the next demand will be for the taxpayers to pay the rent of Negro families in their new apartments, houses and neighborhoods. Even this will not be all.

WE PREDICT

that soon someone like Joe Clark or Jacob Javits (if they are still in the Senate) will be proposing a law to prevent any White person from moving out of a house or apartment if a Negro moves in. At the present rate of "progress in race relations" this proposal will be before Congress by 1970.

The American people have been pushed too far. Every congressman and senator who caves in to threats and intimidation from criminals should be retired. The stability of our system of government has been severely rocked, thanks to frightened little men who have jobs that are too big for them.

The American people—of all races—must be made to recognize this appalling fact. They will know what to do about it, come November.

THE 'GREAT SOCIETY' MOURNS

Martin King outlived his usefulness, so he had to be killed. And by making it look like "an act of hatred," his killer also gave the pending Forced Housing Civil Rights Bill the push it needed.

That Martin King was a staunch and faithful worker for the communist cause is indisputable to anyone who seeks the facts. The secret FBI file on him shows that he kept in constant and close touch with top communist functionaries.

King's influence as a leader was fading fast. Even Negroes were getting sick and tired of his hypocritical bellyaching. Everybody knew that everywhere he went violence was sure to follow. He preached pacifism and pullout in Vietnam to help the commies and war and intervention in Palestine to help the Zionists. It was obvious who was giving him orders.

So, living a lie and living for violence, King died the same way.

perfectly. The press, radio and TV cooperated to the utmost in creating hysteria among the people — particularly among

President Johnson went all the way and degraded the Flag by ordering that it be flown at half-mast for this agitator, and he declared a "day of national mourning."

To the simple minds of millions of Negroes, it all added up to a green light for days of happy rioting and looting. In what the *Washington Star* described as a "festive" mood, mobs of laughing "mourners" turned out for the fun of it. Whole blocks of stores were burned to the ground . . . Washington today looks like it has been bombed. Across America, it took 96,000 troops to restore order.

Incidentally, the police, national guard and federal troops were not allowed to use their weapons. If a dozen or so of the looters had been shot, the whole scene would have cooled at once. It's *No Win* in the Great Society—*No Win* in Vietnam and *No Win* on the home front. The better to create total chaos, national degradation and the imposition of LBJ's Executive Orders and dictatorship. Then the Great Society will be permanent.

WE'RE STILL HERE

During the recent rumble in Washington we received phone calls from all over the Nation asking if we were safe.

We sometimes wondered, ourselves. Although the Liberty Building is across the street from the Library of Congress, one block from the Supreme Court and two blocks from the Capitol Building, stores a hundred yards from us were broken into and thoroughly looted by dusky "mourners."

(By the way, if you haven't dialed Liberty Line, yet, you should. It's already proven its great usefulness—especially in times of emergency. Liberty Line is the only way you can keep up-to-date on what is really going on in Washington.)

Thanks for the concern so many of you showed. One man even volunteered to raise an army and march up from Alabama to our defense if we were put under siege. Well, the best defense is a good offense. We intend to go on fighting the Great Society . . . how about you?

In the turmoil of riots and presidential campaigns the threat to world peace by the Republic of Israel goes

unnoticed.

As we go to press the papers are reporting more Soviet warships steaming into the Mediterranean Sea and Israeli forces again attacking the Kingdom of Jordan. U.S. Naval forces in the Mediterranean are now outnumbered by the Soviet navy and the Soviets have safe bases in Egypt and other Arab nations.

Legislative Lookout



As if the passage of the anti-American Civil Rights Bill was not enough, House and Senate riot-appeasers plan more such legislation:

Control Police—S 917, the "Safe Streets and Crime Control Act", is expected on the Senate floor in the last part of April. This bill and its House companion HR 5037, would, in effect, authorize the U.S. Attorney General to subsidize only those local, county and state police units which met his "standards." It would give Federal tax money to those police forces which centralized their power and submitted a (soft on crime) plan he approves. Thus, Federal control of local police could be achieved. Next step: a National Police Squad! Another threat: Senator Dodd has promised that when S 917 comes to the floor, he will attempt to attach his gun bill (S1) as a rider!

Firearms Control—The Judiciary Committee finished hearings on the Dodd bill, but not until it slapped down some of its most restrictive parts. Committee members approved only that part dealing with the interstate shipment of *handguns*; they refused to approve such controls of rifles and shotguns. However, it is expected Dodd will move to have his entire gun bill restored and approved when S1 comes to the Senate floor.

Tax Increase—HR 15414. This heavily-amended bill to enact a 10% surtax and reduce fiscal 1969 Government spending by a mere \$6 billion will see more House-Senate conferences after the Easter recess. Opponents of the heavy tax claim it will throw hundreds of thousands out of work and cause a recession.

Asked why the circulation has taken such a dramatic leap, Phillips said, "The main reason is that for the past three months we have been paying more attention to circulation problems, including renewals and the selling of new subscriptions. Our subscribers responded magnificently to a recent circulation drive, and tens of thousands of new subscriptions have been pouring in.

Phillips predicted that the circulation of *Liberty Letter* would reach a quarter-million before the end of the year.

Internal Security—LIBERTY LOBBY testified on S 2988, in support of this anti-Communist measure. The bill would make it a crime to commit acts which would constitute treason if committed in time of declared war. Also testifying in favor of this sensible bill was former U.S. Rep. Howard W. Smith. Author of the Smith Act, he called for the Justice Department to enforce the Smith Act and the Supreme Court to stop nullifying all anti-Communist measures.

Foreign Aid—The Senate has no more hearings scheduled while the House Foreign Relations Committee continues to hear testimony by leftists in support of the proposed 2.9 billion dollar giveaway. Liberty Lobby is scheduled to testify April 26th. Liberals and dogooders seem determined to see Uncle Sam thoroughly broke in this time of crisis.

Bill To Boost

H. Res. 1129, introduced by Rep. John Rarick (D-La) is a courageous call for an investigation of President Johnson's failure to provide swift and firm defense of the Nation's Capital after riots broke out April 4. Rarick said "To have Washington D.C. wantonly trampled and destroyed is a disgusting insult to every loyal American who demands to know why and for what reason."

Congress Put on Notice

WASHINGTON, April 10 (LLNS)—Members of the House who fail to win re-election in November as a result of their vote on the Forced Housing Civil Rights Bill can't say they weren't warned about what happens to congressmen who vote against the people.

The day before the crucial vote on the Forced Housing Bill, every representative received a letter from the Executive Secretary of LIBERTY LOBBY, calling attention to an enclosed advance copy of the May issue of *Liberty Lowdown*, the insiders' newsletter that goes only to Board of Policy members of the institution.

The forthcoming issue of *Liberty Lowdown* contains a very revealing analysis of what happened in 1966 to Members of Congress who ignored the so-called "White Backlash" as if it didn't exist, only to discover in November of that year that their votes for civil rights had cost them their re-election.

One of the most convincing research analyses yet produced on the subject, the May *Liberty Lowdown* points out particularly the rocks and shoals of civil rights on which the Republican party seems determined to founder.
