ENGLISH SADDLES

There are basically two kinds of English saddles: (1) park and (2) forward seat—or hunt—saddles.

The park saddle is a good choice for general pleasure riding, allowing the rider to sit erect with stirrups adjusted to a comfortable length. Park saddles are used most often on horses with a rather high head carriage (Arabians, Morgans, American Saddle Horses) whose center of gravity is further back than that of horses which carry their heads low. Lightly padded, the park saddle has a minimum of leather between horse and rider to allow closer contact and feel.

Forward seat saddles (hunt-type) are designed for jumping and fast cross-country riding. A higher cantle (the back of the saddle) keeps the rider's weight forward, and heavy padding in front of the knees helps to maintain stability and proper leg position

over jumps and rough country. Forward seat saddles are used on Thoroughbreds, cross-bred hunter types and any horse used for jumping.

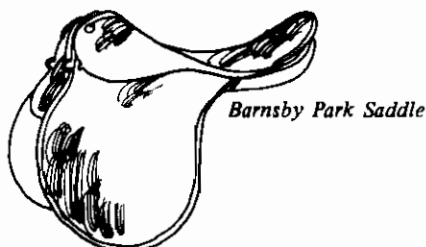
The size of a saddle is determined by measuring from front to back across the top (not following the curve of the seat), and sizes range from 15 to 22 inches. In general, 18 to 20-inch sizes will fit Thoroughbreds and Saddlebreds while shorter saddles are better for Arabians, Morgans and Quarter Horses. The saddle should also fit the rider . . . especially forward seat saddles. There is no sure way to determine the best size saddle for a particular horse and/or rider without trying it out, although an educated guess by an experienced horseman is a great help.

English saddles are priced without fittings (girth, stirrups and stirrup leathers) which are chosen separately to suit the needs of the buyer.
