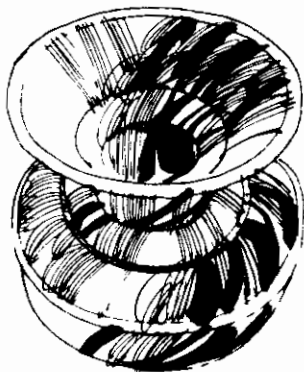


BRASS CUSPIDOR

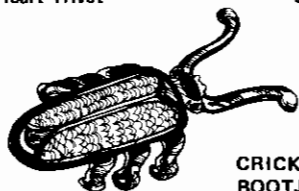

Planting tips:

Cover bottom drainage openings with a layer of gravel, then with soil to the level of the lower holes. Insert plants with their crowns just at the inside of the barrel, spread the roots, cover with soil and moisten. The center of the keg should have a vertical column of gravel for drainage. The crushed stone may be contained in a section of pipe or tile with holes drilled along the sides, or it can be put in place by filling a tin can (which has top and bottom removed) with gravel and slipping the container upward and refilling as the planting progresses. When the barrel is full, plant several strawberries on top. Water and fertilize through the central column of gravel.
