# INTRODUCTION

Dear Folks:

We established MOTHER'S Truck Store in late 1971 to accomplish the following goals:

(1) We hope to gather into one central supply house a line of the old-time tools that are becoming increasingly difficult to otherwise locate: froes, cruppers, straight razors, bottle cappers, windmills, enamelware, broadaxes, cream separators, butter churns, wood cookstoves, etc. It will obviously be easier to live a simple alternative to the consumer life if the necessary tools for such living are readily at hand. Perhaps we'll even provide a sharp enough focus on the expanding market for "outdated" equipment to persuade manufacturers to again produce some of the quality "obsolete" items they've now discontinued . . . which, of course, will increase the options and make the living of a simpler life again that much more possible.

(2) We also intend to make readily available by mail all the do-more-with-less, latest technology products that the modern homesteader needs and wants: geodesic domes, survival blankets, backpacks, non-polluting solar stoves, etc. Perhaps, as we develop a market for "real" goods, we'll encourage industry to apply modern production methods to the fabrication of such items . . . rather than (as seems to be the case) to the construction of increasingly shoddy, overdecorated and overpowered gimmicks.

(3) Too, we aspire to create a market for "cottage industry" merchandise. Items that individuals, families, co-ops and communes—perhaps even you or your group—can manufacture at home or in your own shop: ruanas, butter molds, wooden toys, etc. It's one thing to wish well the people who yearn to break out of the rut and breathe free on their own terms . . . and quite another to help put the dollars of liberation into the pockets of those folks. We intend to help direct a certain portion of this country's gross national product into a true alternative channel of business and living. If you're already producing quality handcrafted tools or just-for-fun fancies (or know someone who is), send us a sample and copy of the appropriate discount schedule. We may be able to add the goods in question to our catalogue.

(4) Most of all, we hope to generate a profit . . . all of which will be turned over to MOTHER'S Research Center which, as you know, will soon (we anticipate) be established to further wrestle with the problems of ecological living and alternative lifestyles. The center is going to need a lot of dollars to tackle the work it has mapped out and we can't think of a better place for our excess funds to go.

The goods offered in our first 28-page catalogue, we admit, were a far cry from the line of merchandise we envisioned . . . but it was a start and your response has been most kind. We believe the 104-page catalogue you now hold in your hands to be a considerable improvement over our first two listings of goods and we expect to make similar gains with each new catalogue we publish.

Please do continue to let us know what you think of our undertaking and please do continue to tell us of sources of goods that you'd like to see MOTHER'S Truck Store carry.

## SOME HERETOFORE LITTLE KNOWN FACTS ABOUT POSTAGE

When we began MOTHER'S Truck Store, we tried to avoid charging for postage . . . it would save our customers the trouble of deciphering zone charts and postal rates to determine shipping costs, and we wouldn't have to send refunds for overpayment, bill for underpayment, etc. But here's what happened: Our "no postage charge" policy limited the number of products we could make available to our customers.

For instance, we found a beautiful, good quality, useful but heavy item which we could sell for \$1.75 . . . but it would cost us \$2.00 to mail it to a buyer who happened to live in Zone 8. We could raise the price of the item to cover average postage, but most folks would then think our prices too high, not considering that the price included average delivery costs to their own home all the way from Ohio. So how could we make the item available to those who could not buy it locally? Charging postage extra was the only answer.

Therefore, if you unfortunately live far from MOTHER'S and you want a bottle of root beer extract, you might find one at your local grocery for around \$.39. If you do, we advise you to buy it there. For those of you who can't find root beer makings locally, it's available from us for \$.39 plus whatever amount the post office charges for carrying the package to your door. Since the cost of delivery depends on where you are, please use the following Important and Indispensable Shipping Information to determine how much postage to add to your order. Overpayments will be refunded.

## IMPORTANT AND INDISPENSABLE SHIPPING INFORMATION

### SHIPPING WEIGHTS

Each product has a shipping weight given which is sufficient to cover mailing the item alone. If several items are ordered at once, the total weight may be less because less packaging material may be necessary to send them all together. In such cases, the overpayments will be refunded in the form of credit memos which may be used on future orders or redeemed for cash. It is to the customer's advantage to buy in quantity . . . one inexpensive item may cost more to ship than it's worth. Actual shipping weights may vary slightly until we standardize on packaging materials, but the weights given are fair.

### DETERMINING POSTAGE

Find your zone number by looking up your zip code on the zone chart which may be found on the back of the order form. Only the first three digits of the zip code are used. When you have determined your zone number and the total shipping weight of your order, use the Parcel Post Rates Chart (also on the back of the order form) to find the postage charge.

### WE GUARANTEE SAFE DELIVERY

MOTHER'S Truck Store does not charge customers for insurance. We insure packages when we think it is necessary, and we guarantee safe delivery of anything we ship.

### UNITED PARCEL SERVICE

United Parcel Service now extends from the East Coast through the Dakotas, Nebraska, Kansas, Oklahoma and Texas. Packages sent by UPS are automatically insured and delivery is faster and safer than Parcel Post, if you would like this added service at no extra charge (send the same amount of postage as for Parcel Post), check the UPS box on the order form. Someone must be at home or arrangements made with a neighbor to sign for your parcel. **NOTE:** Please send your COMPLETE address, and if you live in the country, give clear directions for reaching your house. UPS cannot make deliveries to post office boxes.

### BOOKS

Books are mailed postpaid by Parcel Post, Special Book Rate.

### DELIVERY BY TRUCK (Tipsis, Stoves, Ranges and Windmills)

Deliveries by truck are usually made collect. Please state your address specifically, including any information which would help the driver find your home. Someone must be there to sign for the order and pay the driver. Include your telephone number if you wish the trucking company to call you before the delivery.

### C.O.D.'S

Sorry, the high cost and problems of C.O.D. mailing raise overall prices. For this reason, we cannot accept C.O.D. orders.

### FOREIGN ORDERS

We gladly ship to foreign countries. If you live outside the North American Continent, add 10% to the total of your order to help offset the extra shipping and bank charges. All payments should be in U.S. funds by certified check or International Money Order. **NOTE:** Check with your country's custom bureau to determine approximate duty you will be charged when your order arrives. Refunds cannot be made for merchandise refused because of custom charges.

### PAYMENT

You may pay by certified check, money order or personal check. If you wish faster service, send certified check or money order as we must allow two or three weeks for personal checks to clear your bank.

# STOVE DEPARTMENT

READ THIS IMPORTANT MESSAGE BEFORE ORDERING YOUR NEW RANGE OR STOVE.

A stove possesses no power in itself to force smoke up a chimney. The pipe and chimney give the draft and if they are defective the stove will not work satisfactorily, no matter how good it may be. If a stove smokes and soot adheres to the covers and sides of the flues, something is wrong with the pipe or chimney which prevents the smoke from taking its natural course up and out. When this occurs your stove will not bake, the fire will not burn and the reservoir will not heat.

To guarantee proper and satisfactory results with our or any other stove, be sure to secure proper draft while seeing that the products of combustion are not unduly cooled by the admission of cold air over the fire and into the flues. See that the pipe fits closely on the stove and in the chimney and is well jointed. See that no accident has befallen the stove in transit and that every-

thing is in its proper place. See that you understand the dampers so that you can throw heat under the reservoir or under the oven at your pleasure. See that the front grate and linings are in place. If you will follow these simple directions, you will have no trouble in securing satisfactory operations from your wood-burning stove.

## IMPORTANT NOTE:

When ordering your new wood or coal-burning stove, be sure to check the following: First your chimney should be large enough to accept the necessary smoke collar or stove pipe. If there is no existing chimney, one will have to be built or installed. Second, have a heating expert examine and certify that your chimney is in suitable condition before you hook your stove to it.

These fine cast-iron appliances are made at the Portland Stove Foundry in Malne, a leader in the manufacture of stoves for decades. Each unit, given a minimum of care, will last a lifetime.

**NEW LOWER PRICES.** Due to some changes in their manufacturing process, Portland Stove Foundry has substantially lowered prices on all their stoves and ranges.

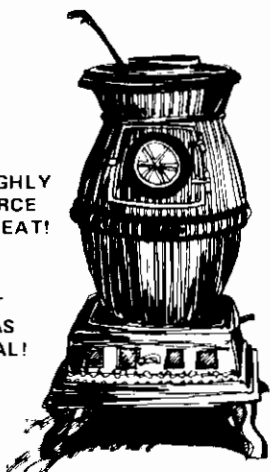

## HOW TO GROW SPROUTS

Sprouts are truly a miracle food and here, in our opinion, are two of the best workers. From only a tablespoon of these mung beans or alfalfa seeds- naturally grown, of course- you can effortlessly produce enough fresh, succulent, super-nutritious "vegetables" for a one-person salad (a pound bag from us should give you four to eight pounds of food). Just follow these simple directions.

1. While you can start with an expensive store-bought sprouting container, you'll probably do as well with some odd or improvised container that you already have on hand. Just keep in mind that the ideal sprout "garden" provides a warm, dark, moist -*not wet*-environment for the developing seeds.

The simplest sprouter of all seems to be a large-mouthed jar. Dump in the seeds, stretch a piece of cheesecloth over the top and secure the cloth with a rubber band. A large bowl makes an ideal holder for the jar during the growth period since the container should be held top down at about a 45° angle to insure proper drainage of the sprouts.

2. Wash the seeds thoroughly, pick out any chaff or cracked hulls and check for fertility (sterile seeds float). Then soak the seeds overnight in a warm, dark place in three times their volume of water. The water should be warm (70 to 80°F) and free of chlorine and fluorine (which can sterilize the seeds' tender embryos).

3. Pour off the water the next morning, and save the healthful liquid to add to fruit juices or stock. The seeds will have doubled in size and should be rinsed carefully to avoid mold.

4. Place the seeds in your container and let the developing shoots grow in the dark for a few days. They should be rinsed with clean water every four or five hours . . . but don't lose any sleep over such a rigid schedule. Be absolutely certain that the seeds drain well after each rinsing, however, for they'll sour and rot if left in standing water.

5. In three to six days, your sprouts will again have doubled or tripled in volume and should be ready for the table. Alfalfa sprouts are about right when they're two to three inches long, but the mild-flavored mung bean may be allowed to reach a length of three or four inches before harvest.

# SAWS

## HAND SAWS

There are two types of hand saws for wood: (1) A crosscut saw is made for cutting across the grain of the wood. (2) A rip saw is used to cut in the direction of the grain (usually lengthwise in a board). The teeth of both types are set alternately to the left and right so as to cut a slot (called a kerf) which is wider than the saw blade . . . preventing binding. A crosscut saw generally has smaller teeth, sharpened at a bevel so that the ends are pointed to cut like knives across the wood fibers. Rip saw teeth are squared off . . . more like chisels, and do not have as much set. To further lessen the problem of the blade sticking in the groove being cut, the best saws are taper-ground, making the blade thinner at the back (the un-toothed edge). The number of tooth points per inch determines the coarseness or fineness of a saw. Blades having more (8 to 12) teeth to the inch cut smoothly and accurately . . . but more slowly than those with fewer, larger teeth. For general work, a crosscut saw with 8 points per inch is a good choice. Rip saws with 5 or 6 points to the inch are the most widely used.

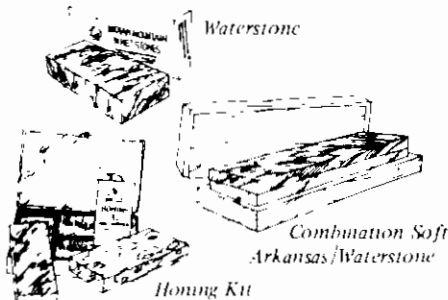
There are two types of oilstones. (1) artificial stones, such as carborundum and aloxite, which are made in electric furnaces and (2) natural oilstones crafted from a rare substance known as "novaculite", a silica deposit found only in the Ouachita Mountains in Arkansas, Oklahoma and Texas. The stone is believed to have been formed nearly 400 million years ago and was first discovered by the American Indians whose early efforts to quarry and make arrowheads from the hard silica date back thousands of years. Present mining efforts started in the early 1800's. The superior honing and abrasive qualities of novaculite are equaled only by diamonds (which are used to cut the whetstones).

Sharpening stones are kept wet with oil to prevent the pores from becoming clogged with particles of metal... a clogged stone loses much of its cutting ability. A very light machine oil should be used, and stones should be washed and dried before storing. An old oilstone can be restored by soaking in an oil solvent or heating in the oven and wiping clean while still hot. Natural oilstones are expensive, but with proper care they will last a lifetime.

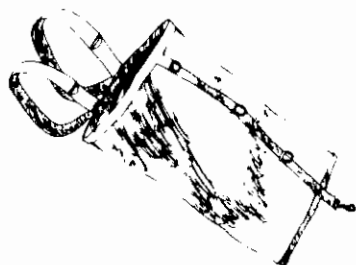

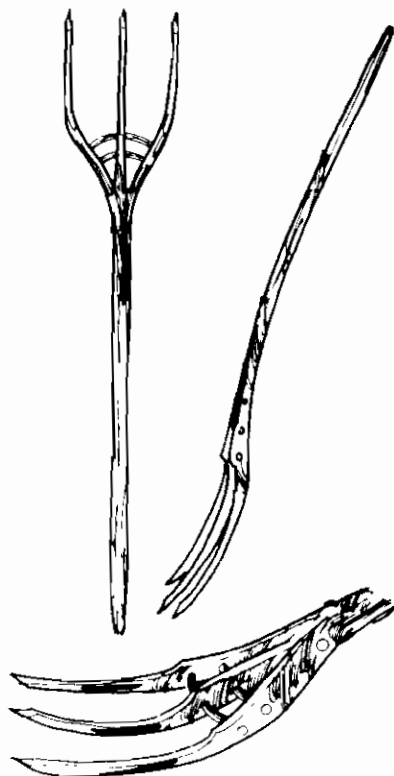

### PITCHFORKS

Our pitchforks are actually made by a centuries-old method, using green wood and hand tools. Steve Levine is the craftsman, and he turns out a beautiful product. First he fells a tree (white oak, red oak or hickory), then splits the best sections of the trunk with wedges and sledges. The pieces are further split with froe and mallet and carved into pitchfork size on a shaving horse with drawknife and spokeshave. The tines are cut apart and spread with dowels.
