

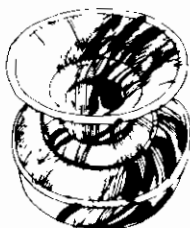
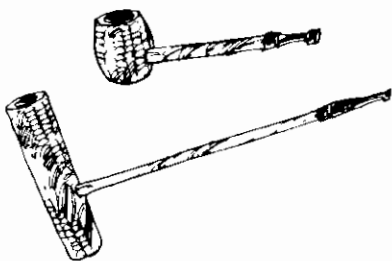
## CORNCOB PIPES

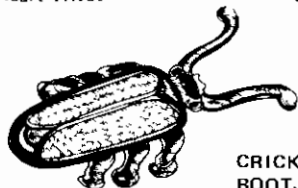

No lights, no batteries, no extra gimmicks... just wood and a child's imagination. That's what the Vermont Wooden Toy Company's playthings are all about. Each of the child-powered toys turned out by the skilled craftsmen who work in an old Mad River Valley high school building is made of select wood (mainly pine, maple and birch) with careful attention to the eye appeal of grain patterns. The well-made parts are hand assembled and held together with wooden pegs and dowels. There's not a nail, screw, staple or piece of plastic to be found in these ultra-sturdy toys. Nor is there much paint or artificial finish on them because the Vermont craftsmen want their toys to taste as good as they work and look. And they work and look pretty darned good.

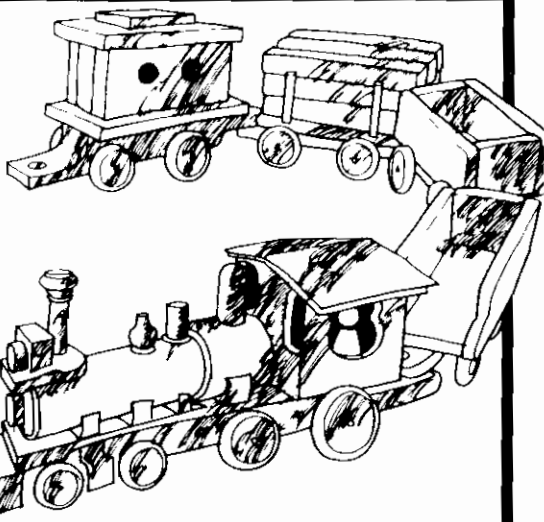


## GREEN MOUNTAIN CHOO CHOO
