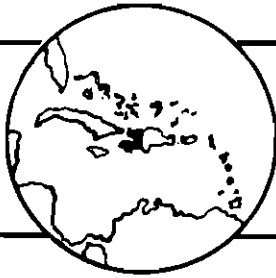

Dear Bill,
