

The NATIONAL CAMPAIGN TO IMPEACH NIXON is an organized network of individuals & groups who are working for the impeachment of Richard Nixon, the 37th President of the United States. It was founded at a conference in Washington, D.C. the weekend of December 8 and 9, 1973. From an initial representative group of twelve cities and towns at that meeting, the National Campaign has grown to include working contacts in 33 states and over 100 cities and towns.

The NATIONAL CAMPAIGN TO IMPEACH NIXON was created to serve three primary needs that local grass roots impeachment organizers felt required national coordination: One is to serve as a clearinghouse for impeachment groups around the country so they might be informed of each others' activities. A second is to provide a sense of the status of the issue in Congress to organizers outside Washington, utilizing information gained from having an office near Capitol Hill. A third is to formulate and carry out a joint program which links up the energies of impeachment organizations on both a local and national level.

The NATIONAL CAMPAIGN TO IMPEACH NIXON has one primary goal: to build a broad-based popular movement to pressure Congress to carry out its legal and constitutional duty to impeach Nixon. As is indicated by the wide variety of grass roots groups working through the National Campaign, there are many reasons why our network's participants believe Richard Nixon should be impeached. Some of those more basic reasons include Nixon's subversion of the Bill of Rights, his impoundment of over \$40 billion in funds allocated by Congress, his illegal secret bombing of Cambodia and waging of war without Congressional authorization, widespread corruption within his Administration, attempts by his subordinates to manipulate the 1972 Presidential election by means of illegal "dirty tricks", his creation of a special secret police unit operating outside the law and use of existing federal agencies --including the Dept. of Justice, National Security Council, Secret Service, C.I.A., and others against the interests of the American people.

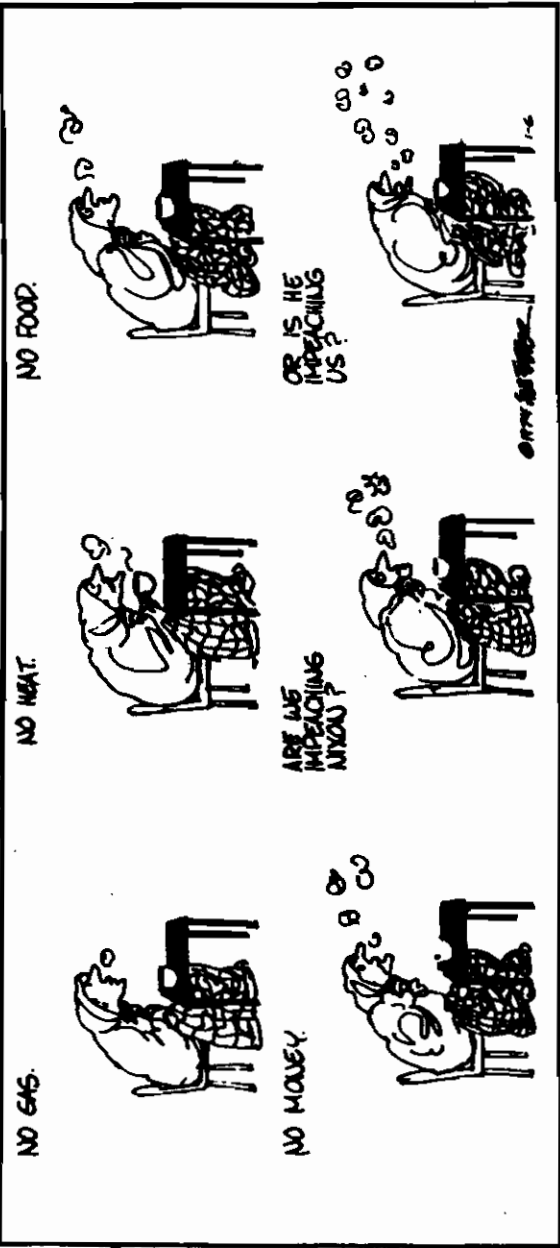
The activities of the National Campaign have been primarily local in nature so far with the exception of a NATIONAL LOBBY-IN held the week of February 4th thru 8th. During that week, close to 400 people from 15 states traveled to Washington to pressure over 90 Congresspeople and approximately two thirds of the House Judiciary Committee.

Local activities have included large-scale petitioning campaigns, town hall meetings, street referenda, impeachment fairs, trials and balls, distribution of bumper stickers and buttons, letter-writing and tape-ins, pressuring city councils and other grass roots institutions to pass resolutions, taking out ads in newspapers, participation in talk-shows, rallies, and visits --even sit-ins-- at locally based Congressional offices.

Future activities of the NATIONAL CAMPAIGN TO IMPEACH NIXON will be decided the weekend of March 1-3 at a National Impeachment Conference in Chicago, Ill. Among the decisions to be made will be the determination of a date for a three-day CITIZENS' IMPEACH-IN in Washington which will include two week days of determined, large-scale lobbying by hundreds, even thousands of grass roots activists as well as a mass demonstration and fair on that weekend. This proposed CITIZENS' IMPEACH-IN would be timed to occur in late April when media and public attention will focus on the House Judiciary Committee which is expected to report to Congress by then. Other proposals for future activity as well as larger political questions going "beyond impeachment" will be explored at the Chicago conference March 1-3.

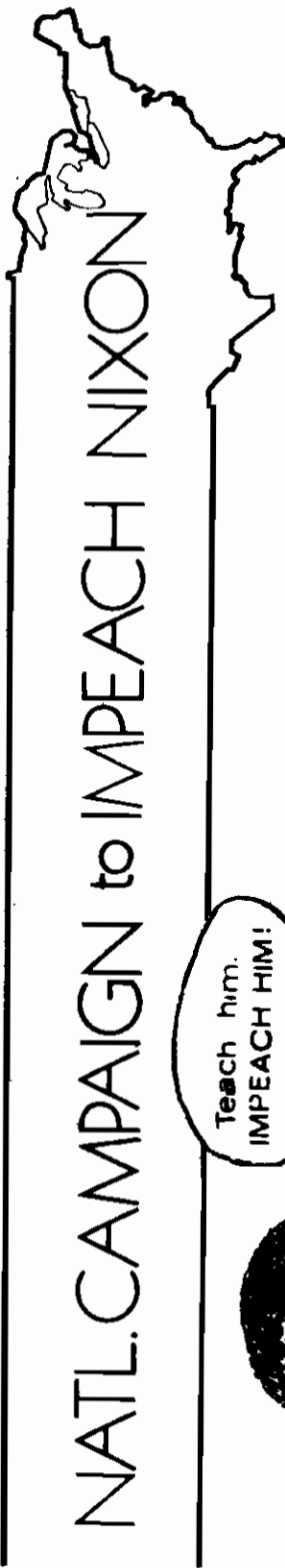
