## IMPORTANT INFO.

Dear Impeachment Supporter,

The NATIONAL CAMPAIGN TO IMPEACH NIXON has just completed its National Impeachment Conference in Chicago. Enclosed you find a report on the conference. You will also find a copy of the "Call to Action" which calls for activities in April as part of the Spring Impeachment Campaign.

We are in the process of producing materials for you to use and would encourage you to get in touch with us immediately if you would like to order more copies of the "Call to Action" or posters, buttons and stickers that we are producing. A key to the success of the Spring Impeachment Campaign will be the amount of materials we can distribute and post so act accordingly.

For those relatively close to Washington, we are available to come to your town to speak and/or meet with organizers to help generate support for the upcoming events. But whether or not one of us would come, we hope that you will involve yourself in the work of building for the Spring Campaign. Below are a few helpful hints to aid in generating larger numbers of people both organizing and participating in the Spring Campaign.

1. Gather together those people who have been or who are interested in working on impeachment. Discuss the upcoming campaign and coalesce a nucleus which is willing to devote a good bit of time to the effort. Figure out the specific responsibilities to be fulfilled for the April 15-20 local actions and the April 27 regional demonstrations (e.g., Activating phone trees, Producing and/or Distributing of literature and materials, Fundraising, Putting up posters, Arranging transportation, Sending out mailings, Handling the media, Organizational outreach, etc.). Assign at least one individual to be a co-ordinator for each specific task and set up a co-ordinating committee composed of all "task co-ordinators" and the overall Spring Campaign co-ordinators.

2. Call a large, city-wide (or community-wide) meeting and invite as many groups and individuals as possible. Be sure to contact labor, Third World, women's

groups and students, as well as groups and individuals who would be more well known as sympathetic. A mailing should be sent out 8-10 days before the meeting, to be followed up by phone calls 1-2 days beforehand. Emphasize that it is a planning meeting for the upcoming activities and not a wide-ranging general discussion on impeachment or even on the actions themselves. It is important that people come prepared to involve themselves in some way in organizing work.

3. At the city-wide meeting explain the Spring Campaign program and the committees which have been established. After a brief period of Questions and Answers, break up into workshops with each committee to begin working on making the actions be what they can be.
