April 15th **IRS Tax Day Demonstrations**

SMALL BUT FAIRLY VISIBLE TAX DAY ACTIONS TOOK PLACE IN COLUMBUS, MO.; MADISON, WISC.; MILWAUKEE, WISC.; LOS ANGELES, CA.; ROCHESTER, N.Y.; NEW YORK CITY; LOUISVILLE, KY; PITTSBURG, PA; WASHINGTON, D.C. MOST WERE COVERED BY LOCAL MEDIA AND THE N.Y. TIMES, CBS, ETC. SHOWED UP AT THE D.C. ACTION.

April 15th-20th **Hometown Actions**

IN PLACES WHERE ACTIVITY HAS PREVIOUSLY HAPPENED, THE AMOUNT OF HOMETOWN ACTIONS WAS LESS. HOWEVER, TOWNS WHICH PREVIOUSLY HAD NO ACTIVITY WITNESSED SPIRITED ACTIONS. FOR EXAMPLE, MOORHEAD, MINNESOTA CITIZENS MARCHED ON CONG. BOB BERGLAND'S DISTRICT OFFICE ON TUESDAY, DELAWARE'S 1ST. STATE COMM. MARCHED TO PETE DUPONT'S DISTRICT OFFICE FRIDAY, MINNEAPOLIS & OHIO NAM CHAPTERS HELD FAIRS, ETC. SEVERAL LOCAL COMMITTEES & INDOCHINA PEACE CAMPAIGN AFFILIATES ARE PLANNING ACTIVITIES FOR THE FIRST WEEK OF MAY.

April 24-6th **Lobby-In**

ONE OR TWO LARGE DELEGATIONS ARE EXPECTED

TO ARRIVE IN WASHINGTON DURING THE THREE DAYS BEFORE APRIL 27TH, BUT THE MAJORITY OF CITIZEN LOBBISTS VISITING CAPITOL HILL WED, THURS, & FRIDAY WILL BE SMALL GROUPS WHO'VE CALLED TO SAY THEY WILL BE COMING EARLY. WE WELCOME LAST MINUTE DELEGATIONS DURING THIS CRUCIAL WEEK WHEN NIXON WILL MOST LIKELY HOLD CONGRESS IN CONTEMPT AND ONLY PARTIALLY COMPLY WITH ITS SUBPONEA.

12 NOON MARCH up Constitution Ave. to the Capitol
1 PM RALLY in front of the Capitol
2:30 PM IMPEACHMENT FAIR on the Mall

THE ABOVE MARCH SCHEDULE SHOULD DETERMINE EAST COAST & NEAR MIDWEST ORGANIZERS' BUS & CAR POOL DEPARTURES. SO FAR (10 DAYS BEFORE THE 27TH), 30 CITIES HAVE CALLED TO SAY THEY ARE DEFINITELY SENDING "AT LEAST ONE BUS". SEVERAL HAVE REPORTED ENTHUSIASTIC RESPONSES, SOME HAVE FILLED 7 OR MORE BUSES ALREADY; EVEN THOUGH A FEW BUS COMPANIES WON'T CHARTER. CAR POOLS SHOULD BE FORMED BY LOCAL COORDINATORS IN SUCH CASES.

BUSES CAN LET PEOPLE OFF AT THE LINCOLN MEMORIAL POOL IN A PARKING STREET TO THE SIDE OF THE POOL (17TH & MAINE NAVY). BUSES CAN PARK AT THE CAPITOL MALL ON MADISON DR. BETWEEN 4TH. & 6TH. STREETS.

SPEAKERS DEFINITELY CONFIRMED ARE CONG. PARREN MITCHELL (BLACK CAUCUS, D-BALTIMORE), BEULAH SANDERS

(NATL. WELFARE RIGHTS ORGANIZATION), DOLORES HUERTA (EXEC. VICE-PRESIDENT, UNITED FARM WORKERS), DAVE DELLINGER (CHICAGO 7, LIBERATION MAGAZINE), AND THE OTHER TWO SLOTS ARE BEING HELD OPEN FOR A CONSTITUTIONALIST VIEWPOINT (SUCH AS THAT OF I.F. STONE, CHARLES MORGAN OF ACLU, ETC) AND ANOTHER LABOR &/OR INDOCHINA PERSPECTIVE. ENTERTAINMENT HOPEFULLY WILL REFLECT SEVERAL NATIONALITIES (LATIN, BLUE GRASS, ETC) AND WE'RE WORKING ON GETTING NAME SINGERS LIKE PHIL OCHS, JOHN DENVER, ETC.

IMPEACHMENT FAIR: MUSIC, GAMES, & BOOTHS!

SO FAR, 30 ORGANIZATIONS HAVE PROMISED TO SET UP BOOTHS AND GAMES/PROPS FROM TWO LOCAL FAIRS WILL BE SET UP BY VOLUNTEERS. THE IMPEACHMENT FAIR WILL FOLLOW THE RALLY AND TAKE PLACE ON THE MALL. CALL MARY MCCALL AT NCIN'S OFFICE TO SCHEDULE A BOOTH OR DISPLAY, BRING YOUR PROPS, THEATER TRIPS &/OR MUSICAL INSTRUMENTS.

NOTE: EARLY ARRIVALS CAN CALL NCIN'S OFFICE TO GET INFO: on the location of D.C.'s impeachment center, church housing (4 committed to putting people up so far), marshal training sessions, etc.
